# Flutterby Baby Blanket

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width: 28"

Length: 42"

#### MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Butterfly™ (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 7 oz/200g, 546 yds/500m)
1198-01 Meadow – 2 cakes
Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) 24" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

22 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Garter st Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

Butterfly<sup>™</sup> features a unique stripe pattern where approximately two thirds of the cake is one solid color and the remaining third features a 5-color stripe. This Blanket is worked flat from the center out. First, one half of the Blanket is worked using a whole cake and then with a second ball, stitches are picked up along the cast-on edge and the second half is worked. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

#### BLANKET

Note: Work from the larger solid section of the cakes for a blanket as shown. If you prefer the stripes in the middle, begin working from the smaller striped section of the cake. Cast on 154 sts. Work even in Garter st until one entire ball is used, leaving enough length for bind off (approx. 90"). Bind off all sts. With second ball and RS facing, pick up and knit one st in each st along the cast-on edge, 154 sts. Work even in Garter st until one entire ball is used, leaving enough length for bind off (approx. 90"). Bind off all sts.

## Finishing

Weave in ends.

#### Abbreviations

Garter st	Knit every row.
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
