

## SIZES

XS/Small (Medium/Large, 1/2X, 3/4X)
Shown in XS/Small Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: $36(44,52,60)$ "
Length: 19 (23, 27, 31)"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Butterfly ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 546yds/500m)

- 1198-04 Dockside - $2(4,4,4)$ cakes

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

$4 \mathrm{Cl} \times 9$ rnds $=4$ " in Cl st patt
Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Beginning Cluster (Beg Cl): [Ch 3 (counts as a dc throughout), 2 dc] in indicated st/sp.

Cluster (Cl): 3 dc in indicated st/sp.

## PATTERN NOTES

Butterfly ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ features a unique stripe pattern where approximately two thirds of the cake is one solid color and the remaining third features a 5 -color stripe. This Cardigan is worked in 2 pieces using 1 or 2 cakes per piece from the underarm out. You will make 2 large hexagons that are folded and seamed together at the back, shoulders and sleeves. Each hexagon makes one side and one sleeve of the Cardigan. Work begins from smaller striped section of the cake for a striped effect, larger sizes will use 2 sets of stripes. Join all rounds with a slip stitch.

## CARDIGAN

Granny Hexagon (Make 2)
Note: Work from the smaller striped section of the cake, so the stripes begin at the underarm. Sizes Medium/Large, 1/2X, 3/4X will begin with the stripe sections from two cakes per hexagon. Once all stripes have been worked from the cake, work the remainder of rounds as instructed in the pattern using the larger solid portion of 1 or both cakes.
Ch 6, join to first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Beg Cl, ch 2, (Cl, ch 2) 5 times, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-3-6 Cl.
Rnd 2: Sl st in next 2 dc , sl in next ch-2 sp, (Beg $\mathrm{Cl}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{Cl})$ in same sp ( $1^{\text {st }}$ corner made), ch $1,{ }^{*}(\mathrm{Cl}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{Cl})$ in next ch-2 sp (next corner made), ch 1 ; rep from * around, join to $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of beg ch-3-12 Cl (6 corners).

Rnd 3: Sl st in next 2 dc , sl in next ch-2 sp (Beg Cl, ch 2, $\mathrm{Cl})$ in same $\mathrm{sp},{ }^{*}$ ch $1, \mathrm{Cl}$ in next ch-1 sp, ch $1^{* *}$, (Cl, ch $2, \mathrm{Cl}$ ) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * around, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-3-18 Cl (6 corners). Rnd 4: Sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-2 sp (Beg Cl, ch $2, \mathrm{Cl})$ in same $\mathrm{sp},{ }^{* *} \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} \mathrm{Cl}$ in next ch-1 sp, ch $1^{*}$ rep from * to * to next ch-2 sp, ( $\mathbf{C l}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{Cl})$ in next ch-2 sp ; rep from ** to last ch-2 sp, then rep from * to * to end, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-3.
Rnds 5-21 (25, 30, 35): Rep Rnd 4. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Match opposite corners of hexagon together and fold to form an "L" shape with RS facing out. Rep with second hexagon.
Sew backs together taking care to keep Clusters aligned.
Sew tops of sleeves and shoulders leaving approximately $3(31 / 2,4,41 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ unsewn at both inner corners for the neck opening.
Weave in ends.
