$2-4$ yrs (6-8) yrs
Shown in 6-8 yrs Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck circumference: 17 (20)"
Length: $1411 / 4(143 / 4)$ "

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Butterfly ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 546 yds/500m)

- 1198-04 Dockside - 1 (1) cake

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, 2 removable stitch markers

## GAUGE

Patt rep: Sh, ch 1, dc, ch 1
2 patt reps $\times 7$ rows $=4$ "
Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Foundation single crochet ( fsc ): Ch 2 , insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yo, pull up a lp (2 Ips hook), yo, pull through 1 lp (1 ch made), yo, pull through 2 lps (foundation single crochet completed), *insert hook under the 2 lps of the ch at bottom of st just made, yo, pull up a lp, yo, pull through 1 lp , yo, pull through 2 lps ; rep from * to desired number of foundation single crochet.

Shell (Sh): (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in indicated st

## PATTERN NOTES

Butterfly ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ features a unique stripe pattern where approximately two thirds of the cake is one solid color and the remaining third features a 5 -color stripe.
This Poncho is worked from the neck down starting with the larger solid section of the cake and in joined rounds without turning. Increases occur every third round at two points to form a V-neck in the center front and center back. Join all rounds with a slip stitch. Pattern is written for 1 cake of yarn. A longer poncho can be made using 2 cakes and continuing the pattern repeat if desired. Keep the stripe sequence in mind and add the $2^{\text {nd }}$ cake accordingly if choosing to increase the length.

## PONCHO

Note: Sample poncho begins at the neck with the larger solid section of the cake and ends with the smaller striped section. This pattern can be made with smaller striped section beginning at neck if desired. Pm in center st of each corner made, move marker up each rnd as instructed.
Setup: Leaving a $10^{\prime \prime}$ tail, fsc 80 (96), being careful not to twist, join last sc to first sc with a slst.
Note: Use the tail to sew the bottom of the first $f s c$ to the bottom of the last fsc to close the gap.

## Mariposa Poncho

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 throughout), sk next 3 sts, Sh in next st, ch 1 , sk next 3 sts , (dc, ch 1) 3 times in next st (pm in center dc, back corner made), *sk next 3 sts, $\mathbf{S h}$ in next st, ch 1 sk next 3 sts, dc in next st, ch $1^{*}$ rep from * to * 4 (5) more times, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, (dc, ch 1) 3 times in next st (pm in center dc, front corner made), work from * to * 4 (5) times, omitting (dc, ch 1 ) on last rep, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-4-10 (12) Sh and 2 corners.
Rnd 2: Ch $4, \mathbf{S h}$ in ch-2 sp of next $\mathbf{S h}$, ch 1 , dc in first dc of first corner, ch 1, (dc, ch 1) 3 times in marked st, (pm in center dc just made), * dc in next dc, ch 1, Sh in ch-2 sp of next Sh, ch 1* rep from * to * to next corner, dc in first dc of next corner, ch 1, (dc, ch 1) 3 times in marked st ( $p m$ in center dc just made), rep from * to * to end, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-4 10 (12) Sh and 2 corners.
Rnd 3: Ch 4, *Sh in ch-2 sp of next Sh, ch 1 , dc in next dc, ch $1^{*},{ }^{* *}$ sk next (ch-1, dc), Sh in next ch-1 sp of corner, (ch 1, dc, ch 1) in marked st, (pm in dc just made), Sh in next ch-1 sp of corner, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch $1^{* *}$, rep from * to * to next corner, then rep from
** to ${ }^{* *}$, then rep from * to * to end, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, join to $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of beg ch-414 (16) Sh and 2 corners, 4 Sh inc'd.
Rnd 4: Ch 4, [* Sh in ch-2 sp of next Sh, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1* rep from * to * to marked st, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, (dc, ch 1) 3 times in marked st ( $p m$ in center $d c$ )] twice, then rep from * to * to end, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-4-14 (16) Sh and 2 corners.

Rnd 5: Ch 4, [ ${ }^{*}$ Sh in ch-2 sp of next Sh, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1*, rep from * to * to marked st, (dc, ch 1) 3 times in marked st, (pm in center dc), dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, then rep from * to * to end, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, join to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-4 14 (16) Sh and 2 corners.
Rnd 6: Ch 4, [ ${ }^{*}$ Sh in ch-2 sp of next Sh, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1* rep from * to * to next corner, sk next (ch 1, dc), Sh in next ch-1 sp of corner, (ch 1, dc, ch 1) in marked st, (pm in dc just made), Sh in next ch-1 sp of corner, ch 1, sk next (dc, ch 1), dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, then rep from * to * to end, omitting (dc, ch 1) on last rep, join to $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of beg $\mathrm{ch}-4$ 18 (20) Sh and 2 corners, 4 Sh inc'd.
Rnds 4-26 (25): Rep Rnds 4-6 increasing every third rnd, end having just worked a Rnd 5 (4) 42 (44) Sh and 2 corners. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
