



Butternut Mitts

Level: Intermediate

SIZE

Adult Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hand circumference: 7"

Length: 9"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Alpaca Dance* (75% Acrylic, 25% Alpaca; 100gm/371 yds)

- #25-02 New Rust – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) double pointed needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Granite Relief St (multiple of 2)

Rnd 1: *P2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: [K1, p1] in each st around.

Rnds 3 and 4: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

Stockinette St (St st)

Knit every rnd.

MITTS

Cast on 44 sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd.

Purl 1 rnd.

Work in Granite Relief St until piece measures 4 ¼", ending with Rnd 3 of patt.

Next rnd – Dec Rnd: *K3, k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 36 sts.

Knit 2 rnds.

Thumb gusset:

Rnd 1: K1, place marker, M1L, place marker, knit to end – 37 sts.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3 – Inc Rnd: Knit to marker, sl marker, M1R, knit to marker, M1L, sl marker, knit to end- 2 sts incd.

Rnds 4 and 5: Knit.

Rep Rnds 3-5 five more times – 13 sts between markers for gusset, 49 sts total.

Next rnd: Knit to marker, remove marker, sl next 13 sts to waste yarn for thumb, remove marker, knit to end – 36 sts.

Knit 5 rnds even.

Next rnd – Inc Rnd: *K4, M1L; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 44 sts.

Work Rnds 1-4 of Granite Relief st, then work Rnds 1 and 2 again.

Bind off.

Thumb:

Return 13 held sts to needles.

Rnd 1: *K4, M1L; rep from * 2 more times, k1, pick up and knit 2 sts in gap, join to work in the rnd – 18 sts.

Work Rnds 1-4 of Granite Relief st, then work Rnds 1 and 2 again.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends, using yarn tails to close up any gaps at base of thumbs.

Abbreviations

dec	decrease(d)
inc	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
M1L	make 1 left leaning
M1R	make 1 right leaning
rep	repeat
rnd	round(s)
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 stitches together
patt	pattern
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
