

Sweet Tooth Poncho

SIZES

2-4 yrs (6-8) yrs

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck circumference: 16 (181/4)"

Length: 15 (17½)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Candy Shop™ (100% acrylic; 140 gm/ 260 yds)

#1057-16 Gummy Bear - 2 balls
Needle: US Size 10 (6mm) circular needles 16, 24 and 32" long or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sts x 20 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch Save time; check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This poncho is knit in one piece from the top down. Start with the shortest circular needle, then switch to progressively longer needles as the number of stitches grows and the work begins to feel crowded.

PONCHO

On 16" circular, cast on 56 (64) sts; pm and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: Knit. Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnds 1 and 2, 2 more times.

Rnd 7: * K7 (8), pm; rep from * to end – 8 markers placed

Rnd 8: * K1, m1, knit to 1 st before marker, m1,

k1; rep from * to end – 16 sts increased.

Rnds 9-13: Knit.

Rep Rnds 8-13, 8 (10) more times – 200 (240) sts.

Ruffle

Rnd 1: * K4, yo; rep from * to end – 250 (300) sts.

Rnds 2 and 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: * K5, yo; rep from * to end – 3.00 (360) sts.

Rnds 5 and 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: * K6, yo; rep from * to end – 350

(420) sts.

Rnds 8 and 9: Knit.

Rnd 10: * K7, yo; rep from * to end – 400

(480) sts.

Rnds 11 and 12: Knit.

Rnd 13: Purl. Rnd 14: Knit. Rnd 15: Purl. Bind off.

Abbreviations

k knitm1 make 1

pm place marker on needle

rep repeat rnd(s) round(s) st(s) stitch(es) yo yarn over
