# **PREMIER**®



#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 50" Width: 48"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Canyon Colors™ (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

• MC: 2098-05 Retro Sunset – 8 balls

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Chunky (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

• CC1: 700-68 Thistle – 4 balls

CC2: 700-60 Goldenrod – 4 balls

**Hook:** US Size M-13 (9 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge* 

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

9 sts x 9 rows = 4" in Weaving Stitch **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and long double crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.

#### STITCH GUIDE

Long DC – Long Double Crochet: Yo, pull up a loop in indicated st/sp, draw loop up to height of current row, [yo, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

**Weaving Stitch** (multiple of 4 + 1 for foundation ch)

**Foundation Row:** With MC, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn.

**Row 1:** With MC, ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Drop MC. Pull CC1 through last loop.

Row 2: With CC1, ch 1, sc in 1st sc, sc in each

of the next 2 sc, \*[working over sts in previous 2 rows, Long DC in next ch of foundation ch] twice, sk 2 sc behind Long DC just worked, sc in each of the next 2 sc; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last sc, turn.

**Row 3:** With CC1, ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, \*ch 2, sk next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* across, ending with ch 2, sk next 2 sc, sc in last sc, turn. Drop CC1. Pull MC through last loop.

**Row 4:** With MC, ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, \*[working over sts in previous 2 rows, **Long DC** in next sc 3 rows below] twice, sk ch-2 space behind **Long DC** just worked, ch 2, sk next 2 sc; rep from \* across, ending with 2 **Long DC**, 1 sc in last sc, turn.

Row 5: With MC, ch 1, sc in 1st sc, \*sc in each of the next 2 dc \*\*, 2 sc in next ch-2 space; rep from \* ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 6: With CC2, ch 1, sc in 1st sc, \* sc in each of the next 2 sc, [working over sts in previous 2 rows, Long DC in next sc 3 rows below] twice, rep from \* across to last 3 sts, sc in last 3 sc, turn.

Row 7: With CC2, rep Row 3. Rows 8-9: With MC, rep Rows 4-5. Rows 10-11: With CC1, rep Rows 6-7. Rep Rows 4-11 for pattern.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Do not cut yarn after each color change, carry up sides of work.

#### **THROW**

Ch 109. Work in **Weaving Stitch** until piece measures 50", ending with Row 7 or 11.

**Next Row:** With MC, ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, \*[working over sts in previous 2 rows, **Long DC** in next sc 3 rows below] twice, sc in each of next 2 sc; rep

## project continued

from \* across to last 3 sts, **Long DC** in next 2 sts, sc in next st, turn.

Next Row: With MC, sc in each st across.

Do not fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

### **Edging**

Join MC to any corner st.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc evenly around Throw, working 3 sc in each corner, join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Block lightly.




