### **Plaid Blanket**

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS** 

Length: 60" Width: 53¾"

#### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns** *Canyon Colors™* (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100gm, 109yds/100m)

• MC: 2098-01 Antique – 11 balls **Premier® Yarns** *Serenity® Chunky* (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100gm, 109yds/100m)

- CC1: 700-21 Pristine 5 balls
- CC2: 700-37 Raven 3 balls
- CC3: 700-67 Brown Sugar 1 ball
- CC4: 700-60 Goldenrod 1 ball

Needle: US Size 11 (8mm) 32-40" circular or size needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle, US Size 11 (8mm) crochet hook

#### GAUGE

11 sts x 15 rows = 4" in patt st Save time, check your gauge.

#### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Applied crochet, slip stitches.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This cozy Blanket features a fun plaid, created by combining stripes and slip stitch crochet added in the purl columns. This pattern is worked flat, but a circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

#### BLANKET

Edging With MC, cast on 148 sts, work even in Garter st for  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".

#### Body

Row 1 (RS): With MC, k4, \*k5, p1, k7, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.
Row 2 (WS): With MC, k4, \*k1, p7, k1, p5; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.
Rows 3-6: With MC, work Rows 1-2, twice.
Rows 7-10: With CC1, work Rows 1-2, twice.
Rows 11-12: With MC, work Rows 1-2.
Rows 13-14: With CC2, work Rows 1-2.
Rep Rows 1-14 until piece meas approximately 58½" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a Row 6.

#### Edging

With MC, work even in Garter st for 1½". Loosely bind off all sts.

#### FINISHING Applied Crochet

Note: Color sequence for vertical stripes is CC2, CC1, CC3, CC4; rep in this order for patt. Starting at either end with RS facing, insert crochet hook into first st of purl column and pull up a loop (leave a long tail for weaving in later), insert hook in next st and pull up another loop, pull second loop through first, 1 sl st made. Cont in this manner until the entire column is complete, fasten off by pulling end through last loop and leave a long tail for weaving in later. Rep for other purl columns.

Weave in ends.
