



## Turtleneck Pullover

### SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)  
Shown in size M.

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 37¾ (42¼, 46½, 49½, 53¾) (58¾, 62½, 65½, 69¾)''

**Back Length:** 25½ (25½, 26¼, 26¾, 27¼) (27¾, 27¾, 28¼)''

Front length is 3'' shorter than Back.

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Canyon Colors™** (100% Acrylic);  
3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

- 2098-06 Rock Garden – 7 (8, 8, 9, 10) (10, 11, 11, 12) balls

**Needles:** US Size 11 (8mm) and US Size 10½ (6.5mm) straight *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, removable/locking stitch markers

### GAUGE

11 sts x 15 rows = 4'' in St st with larger needle

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- K2tog and ssk decreases.
- Kfb increases.
- Placing stitches on hold.
- Seaming.
- Picking up and knitting stitches.

### STITCH GUIDE

**1x1 Rib** (*multiple of 2 sts*)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

### PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed, with a split, hi-lo hem.

### PULLOVER

#### Back

With smaller needles, cast on 52 (58, 64, 68, 74) (80, 86, 90, 96) sts.

**Row 1:** K1, work in **1x1 Rib** to last st, k1.

Rep last row until piece meas 5''.

Switch to larger needles.

**Inc Row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 54 (60, 66, 70, 76) (82, 88, 92, 98) sts total.

Work even in St st until piece meas 25½ (25½, 26¼, 26¾, 27¼) (27¾, 27¾, 27¾, 28¼)'' from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

#### Front

With smaller needles, cast on 52 (58, 64, 68, 74) (80, 86, 90, 96) sts.

**Row 1:** K1, work in **1x1 Rib** to last st, k1.

Rep last row until piece meas 2''.

Switch to larger needles.

**Inc Row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 54 (60, 66, 70, 76) (82, 88, 92, 98) sts total.

Work even in St st until piece meas 18¼ (18¼, 19, 19 ½, 20) (20½, 20½, 20½, 21)'' from cast-on edge. End having just worked a WS row.

#### Neck Shaping

**Row 1 (RS):** K22 (25, 28, 30, 33) (36, 38, 40, 43) (left shoulder sts) bind off 8 (8, 8, 8, 8) (10, 10, 10, 10) sts, knit to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Purl.

**Dec Row (RS):** K1, ssk, knit to end — 1 st dec'd.

# Turtleneck Pullover

## Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times — 5 sts dec'd, 16 (19, 22, 24, 27) (30, 32, 34, 37) sts rem.

Work 2 rows even in St st, bind off sts.

Place held sts on working needle and with RS facing, join yarn.

**Dec Row (RS):** Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1— 1 st dec'd.

## Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times — 5 sts dec'd, 16 (19, 22, 24, 27) (30, 32, 34, 37) sts rem.

Work 2 rows even in St st, bind off sts.

## Sleeves (make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 30 (30, 30, 30, 30) (32, 32, 32, 34) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 6". Switch to larger needles and work 2 rows even in St st.

**Inc Row (RS):** K1, kfb, work even in St st to last 3 sts, kfb, k2 — 2 sts inc'd.

**All other rows:** Work even in St st.

Rep Inc Row every RS row 0 (0, 0, 1, 5) (5, 7, 7, 7) more time(s), every other RS row 5 (11, 14, 14, 12) (12, 11, 11, 11) times, and then every 6th row 6 (2, 0, 0, 0) (0, 0, 0, 0) times — 22 (26, 28, 30, 34) (34, 36, 36, 36) sts inc'd, 54 (58, 60, 62, 66) (68, 70, 70, 72) sts. Work even until Sleeve meas 17" from end of rib, bind off sts.

## FINISHING

Wash and block Front, Back and Sleeves, if desired. Sew one shoulder seam with mattress stitch.

## Turtleneck

With smaller needles, pick up and knit 50 (50, 50, 50, 50) (50, 54, 54, 54) sts along neck opening. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until rib meas 8½". Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Sew other shoulder seam and Turtleneck. Place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Sleeves and then the Front and Back stopping at the bottom ribbing on each side for the split hem. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
