## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 35½ (391⁄4, 423/4, 461/2)"
Length: 20 (21, 22, 23)"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Chamonix (80\% acrylic, 10\% mohair, $10 \%$ polyamide; $85 \mathrm{gm} / 380 \mathrm{yds}$ )

- \#1065-13 Lettuce - $2(3,3,3)$ balls

Hook: Size H-8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Removeable stitch markers, tapestry needle

## GAUGE

20 sts x 12 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Mesh Stitch

## Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Mesh Stitch - multiple of 3 sts +2
Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in first sc, *
ch 1, sk 1 sc, dc in next 2 scs; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS): Ch 1 (counts as sc), sc in first dc,
ch 1 , sc in ch-1 sp, * ch 2 , sc in ch-1 sp; from * to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in last dc.
Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in ch-1 sp, * ch
1, dc 2 in ch-2 sp; rep from * to last ch-2 sp, ch
$1, \mathrm{dc}$ in ch-1 sp, dc in sc.
Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

## PULLOVER

Back
Ch 90 (99, 108, 117).
Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch to end - $89(98,107,116)$ scs.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end.
Rows 3-5: Rep Row 2.
Change to Mesh Stitch.
Work in Mesh Stitch until piece measures $181 / 2$ $(191 / 2,201 / 2,211 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$, ending with a WS row.

## Shape back neck

Next row (RS): Work $26(29,32,35)$ sts in
pattern, turn.
Continue in pattern on these sts until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23)".
Fasten off.
Next row (RS): Sk center $37(40,43,46)$ sts for back neck and rejoin yarn, ch 3, work in pattern to end.
Continue in pattern on these sts until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23)".
Fasten off.

## Front

Work same as back until piece measures $171 / 2$, $181 / 2,191 / 2,201 / 2$ )" ending with a WS row.

## Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Work $26(29,32,35)$ sts in pattern, turn.
Continue in pattern on these sts until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23)".
Fasten off.
Next row (RS): Sk center $37(40,43,46)$ sts for back neck and rejoin yarn, ch 3 , work in pattern to end.
Continue in pattern on these sts until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23)".
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

## Neckband

Rnd 1: Join yarn at right shoulder seam, ch 1, sc around entire neck edge, join with sl st in first sc.
Rnd 2: Ch 1, * sc in each sc to 1 sc before neck corner, sc3tog over next 3 scs; rep from * 3 more times, sc in each sc to end.
Fasten off.

## Armhole edging

Measuring down from shoulder seams on both

## Crochet Mesh Pullover

front and back, place marker on side edges 9 ( $9 ½, 10$, $101 / 2$ )" below shoulder.
Join yarn at marked spot on right back, with RS facing Row 1: Ch 1, sc along armhole edge at the rate of 1 sc for every sc row and 2 scs for every dc row to marker on right front
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end.
Rows 3-5: Rep Row 2.
Fasten off.

Repeat for left armhole, joining yarn at marked spot on left front.
Sew side and armband seams.
