Chevron Hat

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Head Circumference: 20"

MATERIALS

Premier[®] Yarns Serenity[®] Chunky (100% acrylic; 100 g/109 yds)

• #DN700-34 Red Ochre – 1 ball **Needles:** US Size 11 (8 mm) 16" circular knitting needle and set of 4 double pointed needles *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Stitch marker, tapestry needle, pompom maker

GAUGE

11 sts and 16 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch Save time, check your gauge.

HAT

Using circular needle, cast on 56 sts. Place marker for beginning of round and join to work in the round. **Rnds 1-6:** * K1, p1; rep from * to end. **Rnd 7:** * K3, p1, k4; rep from * to end. **Rnd 8:** * K2, p1, k1, p1, k3; rep from * to end. **Rnd 9:** * K1, p1, k3, p1, k2; rep from * to

last end.

Rnd 10: * P1, k5, p1, k1; rep from * to end. Rnd 11: * K7, p1; rep from * to end. Rep Rnds 7-11 three more times, then work Rnds 7 and 8 again.

Shape crown

Note: Change to double pointed needles when there are not enough stitches to fit comfortably around the circular needle.

Rnd 1: K1, * p1, k3, p1, s2kp2; rep from * to last 7 sts, p1, k3, p1, sl 2 sts to right hand needle, remove marker, sl sts back to left hand needle, s2kp2, replace marker for new beginning of round – 42 sts. **Rnd 2:** * K5, p1; rep from * to end. **Rnd 3:** K2, p1, *k5, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3. **Rnd 4:** K1, * p1, k1, p1, k3; rep from * to last 5 sts, p1, k1, p1, k2. **Rnd 5:** * P1, k3, p1, k1; rep from * to end. **Rnd 6:** * K1, s2kp2, k1, p1; rep from * to end – 28 sts. **Rnd 7:** K1, p1, * k3, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts. k2. **Rnd 8:** * P1, k1; rep from * to end. **Rnd 9:** * K3, p1; rep from * to end. Rnd 10: * S2kp2, k1; rep from 8 to end – 14 sts. Rnd 11: Knit. Rnd 12: K2tog 7 times - 7 sts. Break varn. Use tapestry needle to draw tail through remaining sts and pull tight to

close top of hat. Fasten off.

Level: Intermediate

Chevron Hat

FINISHING

Use pompom maker to make pompom according to manufacturer's instructions. Sew pompom to top of hat.

Weave in ends. Block gently.

Abbreviations

k knit
k2tog
knit 2 stitches together
p purl
rep
repeat
round
s2kp2
slip 2 sts together as if to knit them together, knit next stitch, pass 2 slipped sts over st just knit – 2 sts decreased

st(s) stitch(es)
