



# Chevron Stocking

Level: Intermediate

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 15"

**Length:** 21½"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted Heather** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100 g/180 yds)

- #DN110-01 Red Heather (A) – 2 balls
- #DN110-04 Green Heather (B) – 1 ball
- #DN110-02 Golden Heather (C) – 1 ball
- #DN110-10 Oat Heather (D) – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

26 sts x 24 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**I-Cord:** \* Slide sts to opposite end of dpn. Bring the yarn across the WS to the beginning of the row. K across dpn, place needle in left hand; rep from \* until i-cord is desired length.

**Chevron Patt** (multiple of 16 sts + 2)

**Rows 1, 3, 5 (RS):** K1, \*kfb, k6, s2kp, k5, kfb; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Rows 2 & 6 (WS):** Knit.

**Row 4 (WS):** Purl.

Rep Rows 1-6 for patt.

**Stripe Pattern:** \*6 rows A, 6 rows B, 6 rows C, 6 rows D; rep from \* for stripe patt.

## Pattern Notes

Stocking is worked flat and seamed closed at center back.

## STOCKING

### Cuff

With C, cast on 98 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (RS):** K1, \*kfb, k6, s2kp, k5, kfb; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 3:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 8 more times.

### Leg

Begin working Chevron patt and Stripe patt. Continue in Striped Chevrons until Leg measures 12" from cast on edge, ending with Row 6 of Chevron patt.

### Heel – Right Half

Worked in Color C.

**Row 1:** K22, w&t, purl to end.

**Row 2:** K21, w&t, purl to end.

**Row 3:** K20, w&t, purl to end.

Cont as established, working 1 fewer st each row until you reach: K10, w&t, purl to end.

**Row 14:** K11, w&t, purl to end.

**Row 15:** K12, w&t, purl to end.

**Row 16:** K13, w&t, purl to end.

Cont as established, working 1 more st each row until you reach: K22, w&t, purl to end.

# Chevron Stocking

## Heel – Left Half

Cut C, slip all sts to opposite end of needle, join C, ready to work a WS row.

**Row 1:** P22, w&t, knit to end.

**Row 2:** P21, w&t, knit to end.

**Row 3:** P20, w&t, knit to end.

Cont as established, working 1 fewer st each row until you reach: P10, w&t, knit to end.

**Row 14:** P11, w&t, knit to end.

**Row 15:** P12, w&t, knit to end.

**Row 16:** P13, w&t, knit to end.

Cont as established, working 1 more st each row until you reach: P22, w&t, knit to end.

Cut C, slip all sts to opposite end of needle, ready to work a RS row.

## Foot

Begin working Chevron patt, continuing Stripe patt to match Leg. On the first row, hide any remaining wraps from the Heel.

Continue in Striped Chevrons until foot measures approximately 7", ending after 6 rows of color B.

## Toe

Cut colors A, B, and D, toe is worked in color C.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*kfb, k6, s2kp, k5, kfb; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Row 3:** K1, \*k7, s2kp, k6; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 100 sts.

**Row 4 and all WS rows:** Purl.

**Row 5:** K1, \*kfb, k5, s2kp, k4, kfb; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 7:** K1, \*k6, s2kp, k5; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 86 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, \*kfb, k4, s2kp, k3, kfb; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 11:** K1, \*k5, s2kp, k4; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 72 sts.

**Row 13:** K1, \*k4, s2kp, k3; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 58 sts.

**Row 15:** K1, \*k3, s2kp, k2; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 44 sts.

**Row 17:** K1, \*k2, s2kp, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 30 sts.

**Row 19:** K1, \*k1, s2kp; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 16 sts.

**Row 20:** Purl.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail through rem sts and pull snug, then use end to seam closed bottom/back seam of stocking.

## Hanging Loop

With C, cast on 4 sts, work in i-cord for 6". Sew both ends to top edge of stocking at seam.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>s2kp</b>	slip 2, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over – (2 sts dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>w&amp;t</b>	wrap and turn: with yarn to WS, slip next st to right hand needle, move yarn to RS, slip st back to left hand needle, turn work to begin next row
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>wyib</b>	with yarn in back
