

# Chevron Cap & Cardigan

#### SIZE

12 mos

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Cap

**Head circumference: 16"** 

Cardigan Chest: 20" Length: 12½"

### **MATERIALS**

**Deborah Norville Collection** Everyday® Baby by Premier® Yarns (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 113gm/308 yds)

- 1 ball of each of the following will make cap and cardigan:
- #DNE 101-01 White (A)
- #DNE 101-03 Pink (B)
- #DNE 101-11 Fog Gray (C)

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

16 hdc and 14 rows = 4'' for Cap 13 hdc and 7 rows =  $2\frac{1}{4}''$  in Chevron Pattern for Cardigan Save time, check your gauge.

# **STITCH GUIDE**

**Chevron pattern** (multiple of 13 sts + 3 for foundation chain)

**Row 1:** Hdc 2 in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, \* hdc in next 5 ch, sk 2 ch, hdc in next 5 ch, hdc 3 in next ch; rep from \* to end, ending with hdc 2 in last ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, hdc 2 in first hdc, \* hdc in next 5 hdc, sk 2 hdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, hdc 3 in next hdc; rep from \* to end, ending with hdc 2 in last hdc, turn.

Rep Row 2 for pattern.

# **PATTERN NOTES**

This sweater begins with the skirt section, which is worked from the right front edge around the back to the left front edge. Stitches are then worked along the side of this strip for the bodice section. Sleeves are worked from sts along the side of the bodice.

## **CARDIGAN**

#### Skirt

With A, ch 42.

\* With A, work 4 rows in Chevron pattern.

With B, work 1 row in Chevron pattern.

With C, work 4 rows in Chevron Pattern.

With B, work 1 row in Chevron Pattern.

Rep from \* 4 more times, then work 4 more rows in Chevron pattern with A, 1 more row with B, and 4 more rows with C.

Fasten off.

# **Bodice**

Join B to side edge of skirt section. Ch 1, sc 86 along straight side edge of skirt.

Change to C.

Next 2 rows: Ch 2, hdc in each sc to end, turn.

#### **Left Front**

Next row (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next 20 sts, turn.

Rep last row 7 more times. Fasten off.

# Shape neck

**Next row (WS):** Sk first 13 sts, join C, ch 2, hdc in last 7 sts, turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2, hdc to end, turn. Rep last row twice more. Fasten off.

## **Back**

With WS facing, sk 5 sts for underarm, join C.

**Next row:** Ch 2, hdc in next 36 sts, turn.

Rep last row 10 more times.

**Next row (RS):** Ch 2, hdc in first 7 hdc, turn. **Next row (WS):** Ch 2, hdc to end. Fasten off.

With RS facing, sk 22 hdc for back neck, join C, ch 2, hdc to end, turn.

Next row (WS): Ch 2, hdc to end. Fasten off.

# **Right Front**

**Row 1:** With WS facing, sk 5 sts for underarm, join C. Ch 2, hdc to last 4 hdc, ch 2, sk 2 sts for buttonhole, hdc to end, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2, hdc to buttonhole, hdc 2 in ch-2 sp, hdc to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc to end, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, ch 2, sk 2 sts for buttonhole, hdc to end, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc to buttonhole, hdc 2 in ch-2 sp, hdc to end, turn.

Row 6: Ch 2, hdc to end, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc to last 4 hdc, ch 2, sk 2 sts for buttonhole, hdc to end.

**Row 8:** Ch 2, hdc to buttonhole, hdc 2 in ch-2 sp, hdc to end, turn.



# Shape neck

Next row (WS): Ch 2, hdc in first 7 hdc, turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2, hdc to end, turn. Rep last row twice more. Fasten off.

## **Sleeves**

With RS facing, join C to armhole edge at corner with underarm.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2, work 40 hdc evenly along armhole edge to opposite underarm corner. Do not work along underarm edge, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc 16, hdc2tog, hdc 4, hdc2tog, hdc to end, turn - 2 sts dec'd; 38 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc 15, hdc2tog, hdc 3, hdc2tog, hdc to end, turn - 36 hdc.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc 15, hdc2tog, hdc2, hdc2tog, hdc to end, turn - 34 hdc.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc 14, hdc2tog, hdc1, hdc2tog, hdc to end, turn - 32 hdc.

Row 6: Ch 2, hdc 14, hdc2tog twice, hdc to end, turn - 30 hdc.

Next row: Ch 2, hdc to end, turn.

Rep last row once more.

Change to B.

Next row: Ch 1, sc to end. Fasten off.

Repeat for other sleeve.

## **FINISHING**

Sew sleeve seam from cuff to ½" from underarm edge. Sew last ½" on each side to underarm edge. With WS facing and using C, work 1 row of sc along front and neck edges of bodice, working 3 sc into upper neck corners. Change to B. Ch 1, sc in each sc, working 3 sc into each upper neck corner. Fasten off. Sew buttons to left front opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.

#### CAP

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc 7 in ring, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 8 hdc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc2 in each hdc, join with sl st to beginning ch-2-16 hdc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next st; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2-24 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next 2 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 32 hdc.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next 3 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 40 hdc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 48 hdc.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 5 sts, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 56 hdc.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 6 sts, \* hdc 2 in next st, hdc in next 6 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beginning ch-2 – 64 hdc.

**Rnds 9 – 12:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beginning ch-2. Change to B.



Rnd 10: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beginning ch-2.

Change to C.

Rnds 11-14: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beginning ch-2.

Change to B.

**Rnd 15:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beginning ch-2.

Change to A.

Rnds 16 and 17: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beginning ch-2.

Rnds 18 and 19: Ch 1, sc in back loop only of each st around. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
