



Chunky Chevron Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 36" Width: 30"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Chunky Cotton™ (100% Cotton; 3.5 oz/100 g, 50 yds/46 m)

• C1: 2057-04 Teal – 5 balls

C2: 2057-01 White - 4 balls

C3: 2057-03 Storm - 5 balls

C4: 2057-07 Sky Blue – 5 balls

Needles: US Size 11 (8 mm) 24" or longer circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

9½ sts x 13½ rows = 4" in Chevron Pattern Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Chevron Pattern (multiple of 14+9 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

WS Rows 2 and 4: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 3: K4, *k1, KIBL, k4, s2kp, k4, KIBR; rep

from * to last 5 sts, k5. Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

KIBR (Knit Increase Below Right Leaning) - K into st below next st, k1 into st on LHN, slide st off LHN, 1 st inc'd.

KIBL (Knit Increase Below Left Leaning) - K1, but leave st on LHN, k into st below, slide st off LHN, 1 st inc'd.

Stripe Pattern

C1 - 8 rows. C2 - 2 rows. C3 - 8 rows. C2 - 2 rows.

C4 - 8 rows. C2 - 2 rows.

Rep these 30 rows for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from end to end with a circular needle to accommodate the large number of stitches.

BLANKET

With C1. cast on 79 sts. Work even in Garter st for 1". Begin working in Chevron Pattern and Stripe Pattern. Work even in both patts until Blanket measures approximately 35", end having just completed 8 rows of one color. Continuing with the same color, work 1" even in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

C color dec('d) decrease(d) Garter st Knit every row. inc('d) increase(d) knit

LHN left hand needle

purl patt pattern rep repeat(ing) RS right side

s2kp slip 2 sts tog as if to k, k1,

pass both slipped sts over k st

(2 sts dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es) together tog WS wrong side
