



## Columbia Shawl

Level: Intermediate

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Depth at Center: 11"

Wingspan: 50"

### MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Coffee Shop (85% Acrylic, 15% Wool; 3.5 oz/100g, 284 yds/260m)

- 1099-10 Columbia – 2 balls

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 32" circular knitting needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, locking stitch marker

### GAUGE

12 sts = 2" in Main Body pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### SHAWL

#### Setup

*(Note: This section is also charted.)*

Cast on 9 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, [yo, k1] 3 times, yo, k3 – 13 sts.

**Rows 2 and 4 (WS):** K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 3:** [K3, yo] twice, k1, [yo, k3] twice – 17 sts.

**Row 5:** K3, yo, p5, yo, k1, yo, p5, yo, k3 – 21 sts.

**Row 6:** K3, p1, k5, p3, k5, p1, k3.

**Row 7:** K3, yo, k2, p3, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p3, k2, yo, k3 – 25 sts.

**Row 8:** K3, p3, k3, p7, k3, p3, k3.

**Row 9:** K3, [yo, k1] twice, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k2, [yo, k1] 3 times, ssk, p1, k2tog, [k1, yo] twice, k3 – 29 sts.

**Row 10:** K3, p5, k1, p11, k1, p5, k3.

**Row 11:** K3, yo, k2, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k1 (place locking marker on this st to indicate center st), yo, k2, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, yo, k3 – 33 sts.

**Row 12:** K3, p6, k1, p13, k1, p6, k3.

### Main Body

*(Note: This section is also charted. Move the locking stitch marker up every few rows to keep track of center stitch.)*

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, yo, \*p4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p3; rep from \* to 1 st bef center st, p1, yo, k1, yo, \*p4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p3; rep from \* to last 4sts, p1, yo, k3.

**Row 2 (WS):** K5, \*k3, p5, k4; rep from \* to 1 st bef center st, k1, p1, k2, \*k3, p5, k4; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.

**Row 3:** K3, yo, p1, \*p3, k2tog, [k1, yo] twice, k1, ssk, p2; rep from \* to 2 sts bef center st, p2, yo, k1, yo, p1, \*p3, k2tog, [k1, yo] twice, k1, ssk, p2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p2, yo, k3.

**Row 4:** K6, \*k2, p7, k3; rep from \* to 2 sts bef center st, k2, p1, k3, \*k2, p7, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5.

**Row 5:** K3, yo, k1, p1, \*p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p1; rep from \* to 3 sts bef center st, p2, [k1, yo] twice, k1, p1, \*p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p1; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p2, k1, yo, k3.

**Row 6:** K3, p2, k2, \*k1, p9, k2; rep from \* to 3 sts bef center st, k1, p5, k2, \*k1, p9, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, p2, k3.

**Row 7:** K3, yo, k3, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to 4 sts bef center st, p1, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k3, yo, k3.

**Row 8:** K3, p4, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to 4 sts bef center st, p9, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p4, k3.

By Premier Yarns Design Team

**Row 9:** K3, [yo, k1] twice, ssk, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to 5 sts bef center st, p1, k2tog, [k1, yo] 4 times, k1, ssk, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to last 8 sts, p1, k2tog, [k1, yo] twice, k3.

**Row 10:** K3, p5, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to 5 sts bef center st, p11, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, p5, k3.

**Row 11:** K3, yo, k2, yo, k1, ssk, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to 6 sts bef center st, p1, k2tog, [k1, yo, k2, yo] twice, k1, ssk, \*p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to last 9 sts, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, yo, k3.

**Row 12:** K3, p6, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to 6 sts before center st, p13, k1, \*p11, k1; rep from \* to last 9 sts, p6, k3.

Rep Rows 1-12, 8 more times – 249 sts.

## Edging

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, yo, k to center st, yo, k1, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3.

**Row 2 (WS):** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2, 3 more times – 265 sts. Loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block to Finished Measurements.

## Abbreviations

<b>bef</b>	before
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
