

Snowflake Ornaments

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Dlameter: 3"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Color Pack™ (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 14oz/400g, 1080yds/1000m)

1175-02 Box 2 – 1 box

Hook: US Size G/6 (4 mm) or size needed to

obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

1 Snowflake = 3" across Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Magic Ring.
- Cluster stitch.
- Working in joined rounds.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hk under both strands and pull up a lp. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Beg Cl (beginning cluster): Ch 2, [yo, insert hk in same st, yo and draw up a lp, yo draw through 2 lps], yo, draw through 3 lps on hk.

Cl (cluster): [Yo, insert hk in indicated st, yo and draw up a lp, yo draw through 2 lps] two times, yo, draw through 3 lps on hk.

PATTERN NOTES

See last page for a skein diagram with color names referred to in this pattern. Snowflakes are shown in White, Ballet Slipper, and Whisper Blue.

SNOWFLAKE

Create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Beg cl, ch1, (cl, ch 1) 5 more times in ring, join with sl st to Beg Cl - 6 cl, 5 ch-1 sps. Rnd 2: Sl st to next ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp around, join with sl st to beg ch-3 - 6 (3 dc, ch 1) groups.

Rnd 3: SI st to next ch-1 sp, ch 4, sI st in same sp, ch 6, sI st in same sp, ch 4, sI st in same sp, sk 1 st; rep from * around, join with sI st to first sI st, ch 20, sI st in same st to create hanging loop.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
