



## Corrugated Cowl

### SIZE

One Size.

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 36"

**Width:** 16"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Colorfusion™ Chunky** (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

- 1174-11 Painted Desert – 4 balls

**Hook:** US Size L-11 (8 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

11 sts x 8 rows = 4" in back loop hdc

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chains and half double crochet stitches.
- Working in the back loop.
- Seaming.

### PATTERN NOTES

Cowl is made as one long rectangle in back loop half double crochet. Piece is seamed to form the Cowl.

This pattern is intended to use all 4 balls. You may wish to purchase an additional ball in case of gauge differences, or if you wish to increase the size.

### COWL

Ch 100.

**Row 1:** Hdc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 99 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (does not act as a st), hdc in blo of each hdc across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 16". Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Block lightly. Sew end of piece to side of piece using mattress stitch and using diagram as a guide. Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

**blo** back loop only

**ch** chain

**hdc** half double crochet

**sts** stitches
