

My First Crochet Scarf & Mitts

## SIZE

One Size

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Scarf Width: 8" Length: 48"

#### Mitts

Circumference: 7"

Height: 7"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier Yarns® Colorfusion Chunky™ (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

• 1174-07 Wildflower – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size L-11 (8 mm) crochet hook *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

## **GAUGE**

9 sc x 12 rows = 4" in Single Crochet **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

The Scarf is worked flat from end to end. The Mitts are worked flat from end to end and then seamed, leaving a hole for the thumbs.

#### **SCARF**

Ch 19.

**Row 1:** Sc in  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 18 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures48".

Fasten off.

# MITTS (Make 2)

Ch 16.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each sc

across, turn - 15 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 7".

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Fold Mitt in half lengthwise and sew 3" along side seam, leaving a 1" gap for thumbhole. Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**

**ch** chain

**sc** single crochet

st(s) stitch(es)
