

Autumn Gnomes

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 12"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m) (B = for body, S = for skin)

- B1: 700-63 Bluebird 2 balls
- B2: 700-69 Plum 2 balls
- B3: 700-61 Copper 2 balls
- S1: 700-71 Almond 1 ball
- S2: 700-55 Walnut 1 ball
- S3: 700-45 Sand 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Colorfusion™ Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)
Note: (H = for hats)

- H1: 1174-15 Vintage 2 balls
- H2: 1174-11 Painted Desert 2 balls
- H3: 1174-05 Blue Jeans 2 balls

Premier® Yarns Little Bunny™ (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

Note: (F = for beard)

- F1: 2079-11 Toffee 1 ball
- F2: 2079-01 White 1 ball
- F3: 2079-14 Teddy Bear 1 ball

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, stuffing

GAUGE

11 sc x 12 rnds = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Magic Ring.
- Single crochet invisible decrease.

- Single crochet 2 stitches together.
- Double crochet 2 stitches together.
- · Working in rows and in joined rounds.
- Working with textured yarn.
- Seaming.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hk under both strands and pull up a lp. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease): Insert hk in front lp only of each of next 2 sts, yo and draw through both sts, yo and draw

through 2 lps on hk (1 st dec'd).

PATTERN NOTES

When working in continuous rounds, place a marker in first stitch to indicate beginning of the round. Move marker up as each round begins. Join with a slip stitch in first stitch of round. When making Hat Leaves, try to cherry-pick the shade in your colorfusion skein so they're all different colors. When sewing the Leaves to the Hat, be sure that the Leaf contrasts with that particular section of the Hat.

GNOME 1

Body

With B1, create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

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Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 7: *Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 8: *Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 9: *Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 54 sc.

Rnd 10: *Sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 60 sc.

Rnds 11-16: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 17: *Sc in next 8 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 54 sc.

Rnd 18: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 19: *Sc in next 7 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 20: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 21: *Sc in next 6 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 22: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 23: *Sc in next 5 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 24-26: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 27: *Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 28: *Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Stuff Body firmly.

Rnd 29: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 30: *Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around – 12

SC.

Rnd 31: (Sc2tog) 6 times; join with sl st to first st. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread tapestry needle with long end and close last rnd.

Hat

With H1, ch 48, join.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each ch around, join.

Rnds 2-3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), working in the back loop only, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, sc in each st around, join .

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, *sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around, join – 44 sc.

Rnds 8-9: Rep Rnds 2-3.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, *sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around, join – 40 sc.

Rnd 11: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 12: Ch 2 (not a st), working in the back loop only, *dc in next 8 sts, dc2tog; rep from * around, join – 36 dc.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, *sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around, join – 30 sc.

Rnd 14: Ch 2, working in the back loop only, *dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog; rep from * around, join – 24 dc.

Rnd 15: Ch 2, working in the back loop only, *dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog; rep from * around, join – 18 dc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, *sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around, join – 12 sc.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, *sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around, join – 9 sc.

Rnds 18-25: Ch 1, working in the back loop only, sc in each st around, join.

Fasten off, join C.

Rnds 26-27: Ch 2, dc in each st around, join.

Fasten off.

Stuff Hat lightly.

Hat Leaves (make 3, see Pattern Notes)

With H1, ch 7.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 3 chs, [2 hdc, ch 2, sc in second ch from hook, 2 hdc] in last ch; working on opposite side of ch, dc in each of next 3 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Hat Pumpkin Pom-Pom

With H1, make a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Into the Magic Ring, work 8 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd. Begin working in a spiral, moving marker to the last st of each subsequent rnd – 8 sc. Work all sts of rem rnds in back loops only.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 16 sts.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sts

Rnds 4-10: Sc in each sc around – 24 sts.

Stuff Pom-Pom

Rnd 11: Sc in next sc, **inv-dec**; rep from * around – 16 sc.

Rnd 12: Inv-dec around, join – 8 sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread tapestry needle with long end and close last rnd. Cut a piece of H1 approximately 1 yd long and thread through tapestry needle. Insert needle through top, then through stuffing, exiting through bottom of pumpkin. Wrap yarn around outside of pumpkin, then reinsert needle back through the top of pumpkin,



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following the same path. Pull taut to create rib. Use the same steps to create 8 equally divided sections. For the best result start by dividing pumpkin in half sections, then quarter sections then in 8 equal sections. You can vary the height of your pumpkins while creating ribs by pulling tighter which will create a shorter, wider pumpkin.

Nose

With S1, create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring, join -6 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around, join – 9 sc.

Rnds 3-5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, *sc in next st, **inv-dec**; rep from * around, join – 6 sc.

Stuff Nose.

Rnd 7: (Inv-dec) 3 times, join.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread tapestry needle with long end and close last rnd.

Arms (make 2)

With S1, create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 4 sc in ring, join -4 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, join – 8 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Fasten off, join B1.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each st around, do not join.

Rnds 5-8: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff hand and Arm lightly.

Beard

With F1, ch 4.

Row 1: Dc in 4"ch from hk (beg ch 3 of ch 4 counts as

dc), turn - 2 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st, 2 dc in next st, turn – 4 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn – 6 dc.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each st across, turn – 12 dc.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn – 14 dc.

Rows 6-10: Dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Gnomes 2 and 3: Work as for Gnome 1, using 2 and 3 versions of colors instead.

FINISHING

Sew Leaves to Hat in random places on the front. Sew Hat on Body. Pinch hat and sew sections in random places so that it appears to 'slouch'.

Sew Beard under edge of Hat.

Sew Nose over edge of Hat and Body with the sl st seam in back.

Sew Arms on each side of Body.

Sew Pumpkin Pom-Pom on end of Hat.

Fold end of hat and sew to side.

Weave in ends.
