



Woodland Crochet Scarf

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 11"

Length: 100"

MATERIALS

Premier Yarns® Colorfusion™ Chunky
(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

- 1174-10 Woodland – 6 balls

Hook: US Size K-10 (6.5 mm) crochet hook *or*
size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

6 sc clusters x 8 rows = 4" in patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches
- Single crochet
- Single crochet cluster stitches

PATTERN NOTES

This Scarf is worked flat from end to end.

STITCH GUIDE

Single Crochet Cluster (scCL): Draw up a loop in each of the next 3 sts, yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook (1 scCL made).

Tiny Clusters Stitch (*multiple of 2 +1 for foundation ch*)

Row 1: ***scCL** over next 3 sts, ch 1; insert hook in last st of previous **scCL**; rep from * across, ending with sc in last st; ch 2, turn.

Row 2: Starting in base of turning ch, work **scCL** over next 3 sts, ch 1; insert hook in last st of previous **scCL**; rep from * across, end with sc in turning ch; ch 2, turn.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

SCARF

Ch 41.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 40 sc.

Row 2: Work Row 1 of **Tiny Clusters Stitch**.

Row 3: Work Row 2 of **Tiny Clusters Stitch**.

Work Row 2 of **Tiny Clusters Stitch** until piece measures 100".

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch chain
patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
sc single crochet
st(s) stitch(es)
yo yarn over
