



## Marvelous Miter Afghan

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 44"

**Height:** 60"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Colorfusion™ DK** (100% Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 325 yds/298m)

- MC: 1196-15 Vintage – 15 balls
- CC: 1196-06 Seaside – 5 balls

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

1 Miter Motif = 8" square

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chains, single crochet, half double crochet, and double crochet stitches.
- Working flat and in the round.
- Seaming with whipstitch.
- Magic Ring.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

### Miter Motif

Begin with MC and **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3), [3 dc in ring, ch 3] 3 times, 2 dc in ring, join with sl st to third ch of beg ch-3 – 4 3-dc groups, 4 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3), 3 dc in same sp, ch 1, {[3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in

next ch-3 sp] 3 times, ch 1, 2 dc in same sp as beg dc, join with sl st to third ch of beg ch-3 – 8 3-dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps, 4 ch-3 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 corner sp, turn – 3 3-dc groups each side.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] to ch-3 corner sp, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to last 3 dc, ch 1, dc in last dc, turn – 3 3-dc groups each side, 1 single dc each side.

**Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] to ch-3 corner sp, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, 2 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in last dc, turn – 4 3-dc groups each side.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4 – 3 3-dc groups each side, 1 single dc each side.

**Rows 7-16:** Rep Rows 5-6, 5 more times. At the end of Row 16, there are 9 3-dc groups each side, 1 single dc each side. Fasten off MC.

**Rnd 17:** Sl st in next ch-1 sp with CC, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to ch-3 corner sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to last dc, ch 3; working along side of piece, [3 dc in side of next row or ch-sp, ch 1, sk 1 row or 3-dc group] to ch-3 sp from Rnd 2, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp; working along side of piece, [ch 1, sk 1 row or 3-dc group, 3 dc in side of next row or ch-1 sp] to last st of Row 16, ch 1, 3 dc in side of Row 16, ch 3, join with sl st to beg ch-3 – 10 3-dc groups each side. Fasten off.

### PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is made up of 35 Motifs that are

crocheted separately and then seamed together. An edging is added after seaming.

## THROW

Make 35 **Miter Motifs**.

## FINISHING

Arrange in a grid of 5 x 7 Motifs. Join with whipstitch using CC.

## Border

Join CC to any corner.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, \*[ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to next ch-3 corner sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp; rep from \* 2 more times, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to next ch-3 corner sp, ch 1, 3 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 3, join with sl st to beg dc.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in corner sp, sc in same sp, [ch 5, sc in next sp] around, ch 5, join with sl st to beg sc.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, [sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc] in each sp around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends and block.

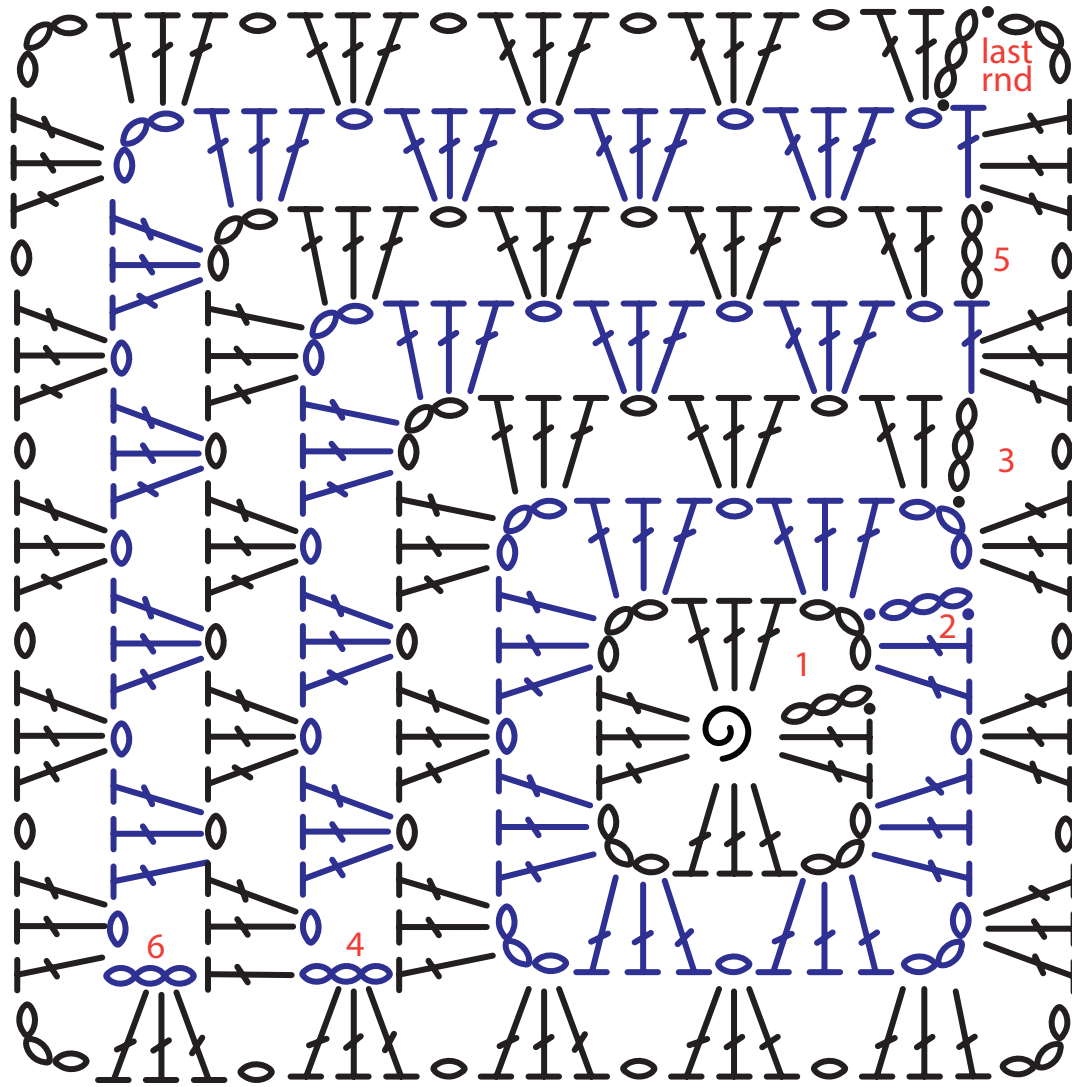


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## Miter Motif
