

Corinna Cowl & Mitts

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Cowl: 30" around at lower edge and 10" deep

Mitts: 8" circumference and 7½" long

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted (100% Pill-Resistant Acrylic; 203 yards/186 meters; 4 ounces/113 grams)

ED100-19 Navy – 1 ball (A)

ED200-09 Beach – 1 ball (B)

Needles: US 8 (5mm) 16" circular and set of 5 double-pointed needles or size to obtain gauge **Notions:** Waste yarn, stitch markers, tapestry

needle

GAUGE

15 sts and 22 rows = 4" in patt. Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Seed Stitch

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end, ending k1 if needed.

Rnd 2: Purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts as they present themselves.

Rep Rnd 2 for patt.

Pattern Stitch

Rnd 1: With A, * yo, knit to marker, slip marker; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: With B, * drop yo, sl 1 wyib, knit to marker, slip marker; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: With B, * sl 1 wyib, knit to marker, slip

marker; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 5: With B, rep Rnd 1.

Rnds 6-8: With A, rep Rnds 2-4.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

COWL

With circular needle and A, cast on 109 sts. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the sts. Work in seed st for 6 rnds.

Set-up Rnd: K2tog, k5, place marker, * k6, place marker; rep from * to end – 108 sts.

Rnds 1-6: Work Rnds 1-6 of patt.

Rnd 7: With A, * sl 1 wyib, k2tog, k3, slip marker, sl 1 wyib, k5, slip marker; rep from * to end – 99 sts. There will be alternately 5/6 sts between markers.

Rnds 8-22: Continuing with Rnd 8 of pattern stitch, work even in patt as established.

Rnd 23: With A, * sl 1 wyib, k4, slip marker, sl 1 wyib, k2tog, k3, slip marker; rep from * to end – 90 sts. There will be 5 sts between markers.

Rnds 24-38: Continuing with Rnd 8 of pattern stitch, work even in established patt.

Rnd 39: With A, * sl 1 wyib, k2tog, k2, slip marker, sl 1 wyib, k4, slip marker; rep from * to end – 81 sts. There will be alternately 3/4 sts between markers.

Rnds 40-48: Continuing with Rnd 8 of pattern stitch, work even in patt.

Rnd 49: With A, knit.

Work even in seed st for 6 rnds. Bind off.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Damp block if desired.

MITTS

Note: Top of wrist has seed st cuff, underside of wrist has ribbing for stretchiness.

Left Mitt: With double-pointed needles and A, cast on 28 sts. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the sts.

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * K1, p1; rep from * 7 times, ** p1, k1; rep from ** to end.

Rnds 3-10: Rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnd 11: * K1f&b, k13; rep from * to end – 30 sts. **Rnd 12:** * Yo, k5, place marker; rep from * to end.

Rnds 13-29: Starting with Rnd 2, work in patt.

Rnd 30 (thumb opening): Work 9 sts in patt, k5 sts using waste yarn, slip these 5 sts back onto left needle and work them again in patt with project yarn. Work in patt to end of rnd. Work even in patt for approximately 1½", ending with Rnd 4 of patt.

Next Rnd: With B, k1f&b, knit to end – 31 sts.

Next Rnd: With A, knit to end. Work in seed st for 6

rnds. Bind off.

Thumb

Remove waste yarn and carefully place the live stitches on 2 double-pointed needles. There are 5 sts below and 4 sts above. Join A and k5, pick up and knit 3 sts in the space between the upper and lower sts, k4 on the other needle, and pick up and knit the 3 sts in the space between the upper and lower sts – 15 sts. Work in seed st for 6 rnds. Bind off.

Right Mitt

Follow instructions for left mitt except as follows:

Rnd 2: * P1, k1; rep from * 7 times, ** k1, p1; rep from ** to end.

Rnd 30 (thumb opening): Work 16 sts in patt, k5 sts using waste yarn, slip these 5 sts back onto left needle and work them again in patt with project yarn. Work in patt to end of rnd.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block.

Abbreviations

k knit

k1f&b knit in the front and back of same stitch

k2tog knit 2 stitches together

p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat
rnd(s) round(s)
sl slip

st(s) stitch(es)

wyib with yarn in back

yo yarn over
