



Color Shift Shawl

Level: Easy

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 56"

Depth: 10"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Collage™ (46% Cotton; 33% Superwash Fine Merino Wool, 12% Polyamide, 9% PBT; 1.75oz/50g, 246yds/225m)

- C1: 1133-02 Brown Multi – 1 ball
- C2: 1133-03 Sea Multi – 1 ball
- C3: 1133-01 Party Multi – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 24" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

24 sts x 48 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Garter st: Knit every row.

PATTERN NOTES

This Shawl is worked flat with shaping on every row.

SHAWL

Solid Section One

With C1, cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: K1 tbl, kfb, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: K1 tbl, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt until piece meas 27" along top edge, end having just worked a Row 2.

Stripe Section One

Cont in patt, [work 2 rows in C2, 2 rows in C1] 3 times, cut C1.

Solid Section Two

With C2, work in patt until section meas 16" along top edge, end having just worked a Row 2.

Stripe Section Two

Cont in patt, [work 2 rows in C3, 2 rows in C2] 3 times, cut C2.

Solid Section Three

With C3, work in patt until section meas 5" along top edge, or to desired length. Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

C	color
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
kfb	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
meas	measures
patt	pattern
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop
