

Happy Snowman

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 8½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair® Bulky (52% Cotton, 48% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 153yds/140m)

- A: 2081-01 White 1 ball
- B: 2081-18 Silver 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair® Bulky Prints (52% Cotton, 48% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 153yds/140m)

C: 2082-07 Waves – 1 ball

Hook: US Size G-7 (4 mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Scrap orange yarn for nose (D), tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, 2 - 10mm safety eyes, fiberfill stuffing, blush (for cheeks; optional), black embroidery thread

GAUGE

15 sc x 12 rnds = 4"

Save your time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and half double crochet stitches.
- Invisible Decrease.
- Slip stitch.
- Working in joined rounds.
- Seaming.

STITCH GUIDE

inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease):

Insert hk in front lp only of each of next 2 sts, yo and draw through both sts, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk (1 st dec'd).

Third Loop Half Double Crochet

Work into the '3rd lp' of the hdc st. The

horizontal line at the back of the st is the 3rd lp. Working into this lp creates a unique, ribbing effect.

PATTERN NOTES

Snowman is made in 6 sections: 1 Snowman (Head/Body), 1 Hat, 1 Scarf, 2 Mitts/Arms and 1 Nose. Join rounds with a slip stitch in first stitch when indicated. When working in continuous rounds, place a marker to indicate beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed. Work tightly so that stuffing does not show between stitches.

SNOWMAN

Head

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hk; do not join, work in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep

from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep

from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 7-14: Sc in each st around.

Add safety eyes between Rnds 9-10 three sts apart

Rnd 15: *Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 16: *Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 17: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 18: *Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from *

around – 12 sc. Stuff Head firmly.

BODY

Rnd 19: 2 sc in each st around – 24 sc.

Rnd 20: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 21: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 22-35: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 36: Working in the blo, *sc in next 4 sts, **inv-dec**; rep from * around, join – 30 sc.

Rnd 37: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around, join – 24 sc.

Rnd 38: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around, join – 18 sc.

Stuff Body firmly.

Rnd 39: Ch 1, *sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around, join – 12 sc.

Rnd 40: Ch 1, (**inv-dec**) 6 times, join – 6 sc.

Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

Thread tapestry needle with long end and close Rnd 40.

HAT

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hk; do not join, work in continuous rnds – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 24 sc, join.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from

* around, join – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, working in the blo, sc in each st around, do not join.

Rnds 7-9: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 10: *Sc in next 3 sts, **inv-dec**; rep from * around, join – 24 sc.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, working in the flo, *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, join -36 sc.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, join – 48 sc.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, join – 60 sc

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sl st in each st around, join. Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

SCARF

With C, ch 79.

Row 1: Hdc in 2^{nd} ch from hk and in each ch across, turn – 78 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in **3**rd **lp of hdc**, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Add 3 fringe on each end of scarf. Trim to 1/2".

MITTENS AND ARMS

With C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hk, do not join, work in continuous rnds – 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around – 6 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (not a st; this is the thumb), sc in each st around.

Rnd 5: Sk ch-3 sp, sc in each st around- 6 sc.

Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Pull up a lp of A in back lp in st above ch-3 thumb, ch 1, working in blo, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around, do not join, work in continuous rnds.

Rnds 8-13: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

Nose

With D, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 4 sc in 2nd ch from hk, do not join, work in continuous rnds – 4 sc.

Rnd 2-3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Sk 1 st, sl st in next.

Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.
Use tapestry needle to close Rnd 4 completely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew Hat on Head, stuffing lightly before closing. Sew Nose on face.

Use photo as a guide and stitch on mouth and eyebrows with black embroidery thread.

Sew on Arms on each side of Body.

Tie Scarf around neck and stitch ends in place. Lightly add blush with finger to create cheeks (optional).
