



## Boxy Pullover

### SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)  
Shown in S Size (with long sleeves).

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 36¾ (41, 45¼, 49½, 53¾) (57, 61¼, 65½, 69¾)"  
**Length:** 19½ (20¾, 20¾, 21¾, 21¾) (23, 23, 24, 24)"

### MATERIALS

Long Sleeve Version

**Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™ Speckles** (100% Cotton; 3oz/85g, 194yds/178m)

- MC: 2086-02 Candy – 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5, 5) balls

**Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™** (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 230yds/210m)

- CC1: 1149-05 Bright Pink – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC2: 1149-08 Yellow – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC3: 1149-15 Turquoise – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC4: 1149-23 Lavender – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC5: 1149-10 – Lime – 1 ball, all sizes

Short Sleeve Version

**Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™ Speckles** (100% Cotton; 3oz/85g, 194yds/178m)

- MC: 2086-03 Sunny – 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) (3, 4, 4, 4) balls

**Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™** (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 230yds/210m)

- CC1: 1149-20 Cadet – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC2: 1149-23 Lavender – 1 ball, all sizes
- CC3: 1149-21 Cornflower – 1 ball, all sizes

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

15 sts x 10.5 rows = 4" in Mesh Stripe patt  
**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single crochet, double crochet, chains, and foundation half double crochet stitches.
- Seaming.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Mesh Stripe** (odd number of sts)

**Row 1 (WS):** With MC, ch 1, hdc in each st and sp across, turn.

**Row 2 (RS):** With MC, ch 1, sc in blo of each hdc across, changing to CC1 in last st, turn.

**Row 3 (WS):** With CC1, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next sc, (ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc) to last sc, dc in last sc. Fasten off.

Note: Following row will begin from the WS, at the beginning of the last row worked.

**Rows 4-6:** Rep Rows 1-3 using CC2.

**Rows 7-9:** Rep Rows 1-3 using CC3.

**Rows 10-12:** Rep Rows 1-3 using CC4.

**Rows 13-15:** Rep Rows 1-3 using CC5.

Rep Rows 1-15 for patt. For Short Sleeve version shown, rep Row 1-9 for patt.

### PATTERN NOTES

This garment is worked in two pieces and seamed. Cut yarn and weave in ends at each stripe. Make the pattern as shown with sleeves, or leave them off for a boxy tee! This garment is designed to be slightly cropped – feel free to

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lengthen or shorten, but keep in mind that your yarn requirements may change.

## PULLOVER

### Front

**Set-up row (RS):** With MC, fhdc 69 (77, 85, 93, 101) (107, 115, 123, 131). Alternatively, ch 70 (78, 86, 94, 102) (108, 116, 124, 132), hdc in second ch from hk and each ch across, turn.

Beginning with WS Row 1, work in **Mesh Stripe** patt for 50 (53, 53, 56, 56) (59, 59, 62, 62) rows, excluding the Set-up row, ending with a WS row 1. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

### Back

Work as for Front.

### Short Sleeves (optional)

With MC, fhdc 47 (51, 53, 57, 61) (65, 69, 71, 75). Alternatively, ch 48 (52, 54, 58, 62) (66, 70, 72, 76), hdc in second ch from hk and each ch across, turn. Beginning with WS Row 1, work in **Mesh Stripe** patt for 10 rows. Fasten off.

### Long Sleeves (optional)

**Set-up row (RS):** With MC, fhdc 37 (37, 39, 39, 41) (41, 43, 43, 45). Alternatively, ch 38 (38, 40, 40, 42) (42, 44, 44, 46), hdc in second ch from hk and each ch across, turn.

Work Rows 1-3 of **Mesh Stripe** patt.

*Note: When shaping, work through Row 15 of patt, then continue to rep Rows 1-15 of patt throughout Sleeve.*

**Inc row:** Ch 1, 2 hdc in first st (inc), hdc in each st to

last st, 2 hdc in last st (inc), turn – 2 sts inc'd.

*Note: When inc'ing on rows other than hdc rows, simply work 2 sts in the first and last sts of those rows. Maintain sts in patt, being sure that dc are aligned with other dc rows of patt row 3.*

Rep Inc row every 8 (5, 6, 4, 4) (3, 3, 3, 3) rows, 4 (6, 6, 8, 9) (11, 12, 13, 14) more times – 47 (51, 53, 57, 61) (65, 69, 71, 75) sts.

After all incs are complete, cont in patt until 41 (41, 43, 43, 43) (45, 45, 45, 47) rows have been worked, excluding the Set-up Row, and ending with a WS Row 1. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements. When sewing seams, whipstitch tog using MC and whipstitch. Sew shoulder seams along outermost 16 (20, 23, 27, 31) (33, 37, 41, 44) sts, leaving center 37 (37, 39, 39, 39) (41, 41, 41, 43) sts open for neck. Sew Sleeves to body, centering at shoulder seams. Sew sleeve and side seams.

For Sleeveless version, sew along sides beg at lower edge, leaving 6¼ (6¾, 7, 7½, 8¼) (8¾, 9¼, 9½, 10)'' unsewn for armholes. Weave in ends.
