#### SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Shown in M size.

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Bust:** 32½ (36½, 40, 45, 48½) (52½, 56, 61, 64½)" **Length:** 21½ (22½, 22½, 23½, 23½) (24¾, 24¾, 25¾, 25¾)"

#### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns** *Cotton Sprout*<sup>™</sup> *Worsted Multis* (100% Cotton; 3 oz/100g, 153yds/140m)

CC1: 2102-02 Island Breeze – 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) balls

**Premier® Yarns** *Cotton Sprout™ Worsted* (100% Cotton; 3.5 oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

CC2: 2101-29 White – 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) balls

**Hook:** US Sizes 7 (4.5 mm) & I-9 (5.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

13 sc x 15 rows = 4" in Spike Stitch with smaller hook

13 sts x 16 rows = 4" in Moss Stitch with larger hook

Save time, check your gauge.

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single crochet, spike stitch.
- Sc2tog decreases.
- Seaming.

#### **STITCH GUIDE**

**Spike St:** Sc in base of st from 2 rows below, sk next st on working row.

**Moss Stitch** (odd number of sts) **Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st) to last st, sc in last st, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sc in next sp) to last sc, sc in last sc, turn. Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 1, sc in next sp) to last 2 sc, ch 1, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn. Rep Rows 2-3 for patt.

Spike Stitch (odd number of sts)
Set-up Rows 1-2: With CC2, ch 1, sc in each st
or sp across, turn.
Row 1 (RS): With CC1, ch 1, sc in first st, (spike
st, sc in next st) across, turn.
Row 2 (WS): With CC1, ch 1, sc in each sc
across, turn.
Row 3: With CC2, ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, (spike st,
sc in next st) across, sc in last st, turn.
Row 4: With CC2, ch 1, sc in each sc across,
turn.
Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

#### PATTERN NOTES

Tee is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. Neck edging is added after seaming. Do not cut colors during Spike Stitch sections. Carry unused color up the side of the work.

TEE Back Hem

With CC2 and smaller hook, ch 54 (60, 66, 74, 80) (86, 92, 100, 106), sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 53 (59, 65, 73, 79) (85, 91, 99, 105) sts. Beg with Row 1, work

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in **Moss Stitch** patt until piece meas 1%" from beg-ch edge.

#### **Main Back**

Switch to larger hook. Beg with Row 1, work in **Spike Stitch** patt until piece meas approx. 14" from beg-ch edge, ending with WS Row 2 of patt.

#### **Raglan Shaping**

**Row 1:** SI st in first 3 (4, 5, 6, 7) (8, 11, 12, 15) sts, sI st in next st, sc2tog (dec), work in est'd patt to last 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) (10, 13, 14, 17) sts, sc2tog (dec), turn, leaving rem sts unworked – 45 (49, 53, 59, 63) (67, 67, 73, 73) sts rem.

Rows 2-4: Work even in est'd patt.

**Row 5 (dec):** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 2 sts dec'd.

Rows 6-8: Work even in est'd patt.

**Rows 9-20 (24, 16, 12, -) (-, -, -, -):** Rep last 4 rows, 3 (4, 2, 1, -) (-, -, -, -) more times – 39 (41, 49, 57, 63) (67, 67, 73, 73) sts rem.

**Row 21 (25, 17, 13, 9) (9, 9, 9, 9):** Rep Dec row – 2 sts dec'd.

Row 22 (26, 18, 14, 10) (10, 10, 10, 10): Work even in est'd patt.

Rows 23 (27, 19, 15, 11) (11, 11, 11, 11)-28 (32, 32, 36, 36) (40, 40, 44, 44): Rep last 2 rows, 3 (3, 7, 11, 13) (15, 15, 17, 17) more times – 31 (33, 33, 33, 35) (35, 35, 37, 37) sts rem. Fasten off.

#### Front

Work as for Back to final 6 rows of Neck shaping. Left Front Neck Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt over 7 sts, sc2tog, turn, leaving rem sts unworked -9 sts rem. **Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to end, turn -8 sts rem.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn – 6 sts rem.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to end, turn – 5 sts rem.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn – 3 sts rem.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc3tog. Fasten off.

Sk 15 (17, 17, 17, 19) (19, 19, 21, 21) center Neck sts, join yarn in next st. **Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn – 9 sts rem. **Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn – 8 sts rem. **Rows 3-4:** Rep Rows 1-2 – 5 sts rem. **Row 5:** Rep Row 1 – 4 sts rem. **Row 6:** Ch 1, sc3tog. Fasten off.

#### Sleeves Cuff

With CC2 and smaller hook, ch 38 (42, 46, 48, 52) (56, 58, 62, 66), sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 37 (41, 45, 47, 51) (55, 57, 61, 65) sts. Beg with Row 1, work in **Moss Stitch** patt until piece meas 1" from beg-ch edge.

#### **Main Sleeve**

Switch to larger hook. Beg with Row 1, work in **Spike Stitch** patt until piece meas approx. 3" from beg-ch edge, ending with WS Row 2 of patt.

#### **Raglan Shaping**

**Row 1:** SI st in first 3 (4, 5, 6, 7) (8, 11, 12, 15) sts, sI st in next st, sc2tog (dec), work in est'd patt to last 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) (10, 13, 14, 17) sts, sc2tog (dec), turn, leaving rem sts unworked – 29 (31, 33, 33, 35) (37, 33, 35, 33) sts rem.

Rows 2-4: Work even in est'd patt.

**Row 5 (dec):** Ch 1, sc2tog, work in patt to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 2 sts dec'd.

Rows 6-8: Work even in est'd patt.

**Rows 9- - (12, -, 16, 12) (16, 24, 28, 32):** Rep last 4 rows, - (1, -, 2, 1) (2, 4, 5, 6) more times – 27 (27, 31, 27, 31) (31, 23, 23, 19) sts rem.

**Row 9 (13, 9, 17, 13) (17, 25, 29, 33):** Rep Dec row – 2 sts dec'd.

Row 10 (14, 10, 18, 14) (18, 26, 30, 34): Work even in est'd patt.

**Rows 11 (15, 11, 19, 15) (19, 27, 31, 35)-28 (32, 32, 36, 36) (40, 40, 44, 44):** Rep last 2 rows, 9 (9, 11, 9, 11) (11, 7, 7, 5) more times – 7 sts rem. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew raglan seams. Sew sleeve and side seams.

#### **Neck Edging**

With MC, smaller hook, and RS facing, sc an even number of sts evenly around neck edge at the rate of 1 sc per st and 1 sc per row around entire neck edge, join with sl st to beg sc.

Switch to larger hook

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st, ch 1, sk next st, \*sc in next st, ch 1, sk 1; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to

project continued

beg sc, turn.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 1, \*sc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 1 sc; rep from \* to end, join with sl st to beg sp, turn. Rep Rnd 2 until Neck Edging measures approximately ¾".

**Final Rnd:** SI st somewhat loosely in each st and sp around. Fasten off. Weave in end.
