
# PREMIER®



Darling Doggo Bandana

#### **SIZES**

Small (Medium, Large)

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Wingspan/Width: 11 (13, 15)" (not including

ties or edging) **Depth:** 5½ (6½ 7½)" **Tie Length:** 6 (7, 8)"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™ (100% Cotton; 3.5 oz/100g, 230yds/210m)

• CC1: 1149-15 Turquoise – 1 ball

• CC2: 1149-03 Magenta - 1 ball

• CC3: 1149-17 Ultramarine - 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker

#### **GAUGE**

15 sts x 17 rows = 4" in pattern Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single crochet and chain stitches.
- Increasing.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This triangular bandana is worked in one piece outward. The edging is crocheted directly onto the bandana. This pattern is written in three sizes, but is easily adjustable to get the perfect size for your dog. Consider making one for yourself to match!

When changing colors, work the last step of the single crochet of a row in the new color. Cut colors and weave in ends between stripes. Suggested striping options are provided in the pattern, but feel free to get creative and make up your own!

## Bandana - Base Pattern

Note: Color options for the Bandanas shown are on the following page.

Ch 2.

**Row 1:** ([Sc, ch 1] 3 times, sc) in second ch from hook, turn – 4 sc, 3 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [sc, ch 1, sc] in next ch-1 sp (place removable marker on this central ch-1 sp and move up each row), ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in last sc, turn – 6 sc, 5 ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] to central ch-1 sp, [sc, ch 1, sc] in central ch-1 sp, [ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp] to last sc, ch 1, sc in last sc, turn – 8 sc, 7 ch-1 sps.

Repeat Row 3 until Bandana measures approximately 11 (13, 15)" wide. Fasten off.

# **Edging**

Join yarn to top of final sc worked from Bandana section.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] to central ch-1 sp, [sc, ch 1, sc] in central ch-1 sp, [ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp] to last sc, ch 1, sc in last sc, ch 23 (27, 31) for Tie, sc in second ch from hook and each rem ch; working along top edge of Bandana, [sc in side of next row, ch 1, skip next row] to last row, sc in last row, ch 23 (27, 31) for Tie, sc in second ch from hook and each rem ch, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

# **Small Color Combo**

Ch 2 and work Row 1 of Base Pattern with A. Change colors every single row alternating through B, C, A, and continuing to repeat this sequence. Work Edging with B.

# **Medium Color Combo**

Ch 2 and work Rows 1-2 of Base Pattern with A. Change colors every two rows alternating through B, C, A, and continuing to repeat this sequence. Work Edging with C.

# **Large Color Combo**

Ch 2 and work Rows 1-3 of Base Pattern with A. Change colors every four rows alternating through B, C, A, and continuing to repeat this sequence. Work Edging with C.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends and block.

**ch** chain(s)

sc single crochet

sp space(s)

st(s) stitch(es)
