FREE CROCHET PATTERN



# Dazey Daisy Bandana



**TYPE:** Crochet

**DESIGNER:** Tori Rahn of Boot Scootin' Crochet

## SIZES:

**XS (S/M, L/1X, 2X)**

Note: 2X size is intended to be human size.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 5¾ (8½, 11¼, 14¼)" *(not including ties)*

Depth in Center: 2¾ (4¼, 5¾, 7)"

## GAUGE:

Daisy Square Motif = 2" across

21 sc x 23 rnds = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## MATERIALS:

**Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout® DK (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 230yds/210m)**

- MC: 1149-29 White – 1 ball
- CC1: 1149-08 Yellow – 1 ball
- CC2: 1149-07 Peach – 1 ball
- CC3: 1149-11 Celery – 1 ball

## HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- **US Size G-6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge**
- **Tapestry needle**

## SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Magic Ring.
- Chain, single, half double, double, and cluster stitches.
- Joining motifs with single crochet through the front loop.
- Working in the round.
- Changing colors.

## STITCH GUIDE

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6” tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

**3-dccl (3 double crochet cluster):** \*Yo, insert hook in st indicated, pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops; rep from \* 2 more times, yo and pull through all loops on hook.

**Beg 3-dccl (beginning 3 double crochet cluster):** Ch 3, \*yo, insert hook in same st, pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops; rep from \* 1 more time, yo and pull through all loops on hook.

## DAISY SQUARE MOTIF

Begin with CC1 and **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join with sl st to beg sc – 8 sc. Fasten off CC1.

**Rnd 2:** Join MC with sl st to any sc, **beg 3-dccl** in same sc, ch 1, \***3-dccl** in next sc, ch 1; rep from \* around, join with sl st to top of beg **3-dccl** – 8 **3-dccl**, 8 ch-1 sps. Fasten off MC.

**Rnd 3:** Join CC2 or CC3 with sl st to any ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, \*3 hdc in next sp, [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] in next sp; rep from \* 2 more times, 3 hdc in next sp, 3 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 1, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 – 12 hdc, 24 dc, 4 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

## DAISY TRIANGLE MOTIF

Begin with CC1 and **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as sc), 5 sc in ring – 6 sc. Fasten off CC1.

**Rnd 2:** Join MC with sl st to last sc worked, ch 3 (counts as dc), \***3-dccl** in next sc, ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times, **3 dccl** in next sc, dc in last sc – 2 dc, 4 **3-dccl**. Fasten off MC.

**Rnd 3:** Join CC3 to last dc worked, ch 3 (counts as dc), 3 dc in same st, 3 hdc in next sp, [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] in next sp, 3 hdc in next sp, 4 dc in last dc – 6 hdc, 14 dc, 1 ch-1 sp. Fasten off.

## PATTERN NOTES

Bandana is constructed from individually made squares and triangles that are joined together with single crochet. The border and ties are added after motifs have been joined. Written for four sizes, you’re sure to find the one that fits your dog (and you?!) perfectly!

## BANDANA

Make 1 (2, 4, 6) **Daisy Square Motifs** using CC2 for Rnd 3, 0 (1, 2, 4) **Daisy Square Motifs** using CC3 for Rnd 3, and 2 (3, 4, 5) **Daisy Triangle Motifs**.

## FINISHING

Using diagram as a guide, lay out your **Motifs** as shown. Join **Motifs** by holding them with RS facing up, working flo sc through both Rnd 3 from **Motifs**.

## BORDER

Join MC with sl st to left side **Daisy Triangle Motif**.

**Rnd 1:** Work 24 (36, 48, 60) sc evenly along side to center point, 3 sc in center point, 24 (36, 48, 60) sc evenly along other side to top edge of Bandana, ch 25 (30, 35, 40), sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and each ch across (first tie made), work 30 (45, 60, 75) sc along upper edge of Bandana along the **Triangle Motifs**, ch 25 (30, 35, 40), sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and (*cont.*)

## BORDER CONT.

each ch across (second tie made), join with sl st to beg sc.

**Rnd/Row 2:** Ch 1, [sk 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, sk 2 sc, sc in next sc] 4 (6, 8, 10) times to 3 sc at center point, sk next sc, 5 dc in next sc, sk next sc, [sc in next sc, sk 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, sk 2 sc] 4 (6, 8, 10) times, sl st in next sc.

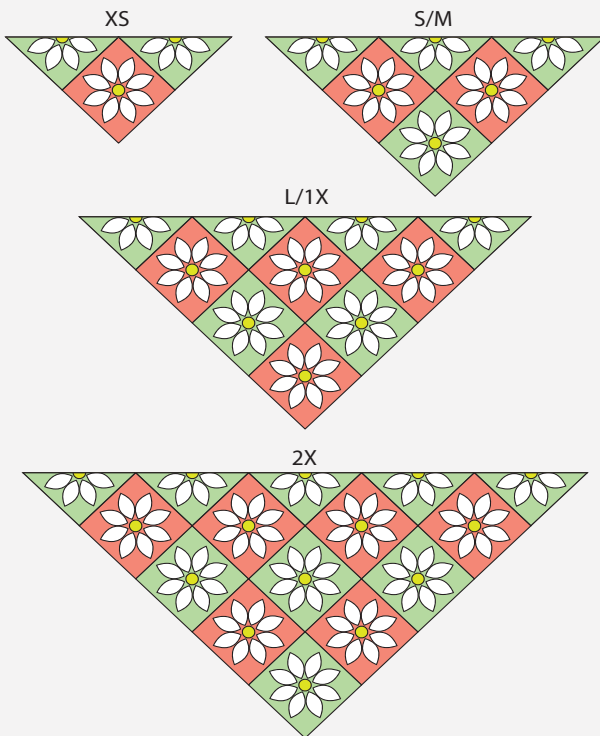
Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Block lightly.

## MEET THE DESIGNER



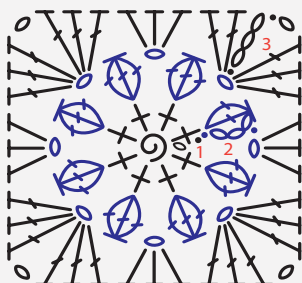
