

Horseshoe Lace Pullover

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 40½ (44¼, 48, 51¾, 56½, 60¼)" **Length**: 21½ (22¼, 22½, 23, 23½, 24¼)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout™ (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 230yds/210m)

• 1149-12 Hunter Green – 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9) balls

Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) straight needles, US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, locking stitch markers

GAUGE

21 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts) **Row 1:** *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

Horseshoe Lace (multiple of 14+3 sts)
Row 1 (RS): *P1, sl 1 WYON, p1, k1, yo, k3, s2kp, k3, yo, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, sl 1 WYON, p1.

WS Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: K1, p2tog (sl 1 WYON from previous row), k1, *p11, k1, p2tog (sl 1 WYON from previous row), k1; rep from * to end.

Row 3: *P1, sl 1 WYON, p1, k2, yo, k2, s2kp, k2, yo, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, sl 1 WYON, p1.

Row 5: *P1, **sl 1 WYON**, p1, k3, yo, k1, s2kp, k1, yo, k3; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, **sl 1 WYON**, p1.

Row 7: *P1, sl 1 WYON, p1, k4, yo, s2kp, yo, k4; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, sl 1 WYON, p1. Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

Slip 1 With Yarn On Needle (sl 1 WYON): With yarn in front of work, slip next stitch purlwise, bring the yarn over the needle from front to back, placing it next to the slipped stitch on the needle. On the next row purl the YON together with the slipped stitch.

PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. For a fit as shown, choose size that measures 4-6" larger than your full bust.

PULLOVER

Back

With smaller needles, cast on 108 (118, 128, 138, 150, 160) sts. Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 3", inc by 1 st on the last row of ribbing – 109 (119, 129, 139, 151, 161) sts. Switch to larger needles.

Setup Row 1 (RS): P4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2), work in **Horseshoe Lace** patt (beg with Row 1) over next 101 (115, 129, 129, 143, 157) sts, p4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2).

Setup Row 2 (WS): K4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2), work in **Horseshoe Lace** patt over next 101 (115, 129, 129, 143, 157) sts, k4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2). Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 21½ (22¼, 22½, 23, 23½, 24¼)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

Horseshoe Lace Pullover

Front

With smaller needles, cast on 108 (118, 128, 138, 150, 160) sts. Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 3", inc by 1 st on the last row of ribbing – 109 (119, 129, 139, 151, 161) sts. Switch to larger needles.

Setup Row 1 (RS): P4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2), work in **Horseshoe Lace** patt (beg with Row 1) over next 101 (115, 129, 129, 143, 157) sts, p4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2).

Setup Row 2 (WS): K4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2), work in **Horseshoe Lace** patt over next 101 (115, 129, 129, 143, 157) sts, k4 (2, 0, 5, 4, 2).

Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 19% (20%, 20%, 21, 21%, 22%)" from cast-on edge. End having just worked a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Note: Maintain Horseshoe Lace patt as much as possible, if there are not enough sts to work the increase and corresponding decrease, work them in St st.

Row 1 (RS): Work 37 (42, 45, 50, 56, 60) sts in patt (left shoulder sts), bind off 35 (35, 39, 39, 39, 41) sts, work in patt to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Row 2 (WS): Work even in patt.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, work in patt to end — 1 st dec'd.

Next Row (WS): Work even in patt.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times — 4 sts dec'd, 32 (37, 40, 45, 51, 55) sts rem.
Bind off sts.

Place held sts on working needle and with WS facing, join yarn.

Next Row (WS): Work even in patt.

Dec Row (RS): Work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more — 4 sts dec'd, 32 (37, 40, 45, 51, 55) sts rem.

Work WS Row once more and then bind off all sts.

Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 46 (52, 52, 52, 54, 54) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 3". Switch to larger needles and work 8 (8, 8, 6, 4, 2) rows even in St st.

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, knit to 3 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every RS row 0 (0, 0, 0, 3, 9) more times, every 4^{th} row 12 (9, 18, 27, 25, 22) times and then every 6^{th} row 10 (12, 6, 0, 0, 0) times — 44 (42, 48, 54, 56, 62) sts inc'd, 92 (96, 102, 108, 112, 118) sts. If necessary, work even until Sleeve meas 20½ (20½, 20½, 20½, 19½, 19½)" from cast-on edge, bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Wash and block Front, Back and Sleeves, if desired. Sew one shoulder seam.

Neck Edging

With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 98 (98, 106, 106, 106, 110) sts around neck opening. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until Neck Edging meas 1", loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Sew second shoulder seam and Neck Edging. Place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Sleeves and then the Front and Back.

Weave in ends.
