## Stained Glass Skirt

## SIZES

Adult XS (S, M, M/L, L) (1X, 2X/3X, 3X, 4X, 5X/6X)
Shown in L Size.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hip Circumference: 35 ( $381 / 2,42,45122,49$ ) ( $521 ⁄ 22$, $56,591 / 2,63,661 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$
Waist Circumference: 28 ( $31 \frac{1}{2}, 35,381 / 2,42$ ) ( $451 / 2,483 / 4,521 / 4,553 / 4,591 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$
Length: $143 / 4(143 / 4,143 / 4,181 / 4,181 / 4)(181 / 4,181 / 4$, $213 / 4,213 / 4,213 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Cotton Sprout ${ }^{T M}$ (100\% Cotton; $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g}, 230 \mathrm{yds} / 210 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- MC: 1149-32 Black - $2(2,2,2,3)(3,3$, $3,4)$ balls
- CC1: 1149-16 Aqua - 1 ball
- CC2: 1149-14 Teal - 1 ball
- CC3: 1149-13 Mint -1 ball
- CC4: 1149-10 Lime - 1 ball
- CC5: 1149-08 Yellow - 1 ball
- CC6: 1149-06 Blush - 1 ball
- CC7: 1149-04 Cardinal- 1 ball
- CC8: 1149-03 Magenta - 1 ball

Hook: US Sizes H-8 (5 mm) and I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, drawstring cord (optional)

## GAUGE

1 Motif = $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square with larger hook
15 sts $\times 16$ rows $=4$ " in single crochet with smaller hook
15 sts $\times 18$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Moss Stitch with larger hook
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Working in the round.
- Single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, and chains.
- Decreasing (sc2tog).
- Joining motifs with slip stitches.


## STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

## Motif

Begin with Magic Ring and larger hook.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and
throughout), 11 dc in ring, join with sl st to beg dc with new color - 12 dc .
Rnd 2: Sl st bet next 2 dc , ch 3, dc in same sp, ( 2 dc bet next 2 dc ) around, join with sl st to beg dc with new color -24 dc .
Rnd 3: Ch 5 (counts as dc + ch 3), 2 dc in same sp , *(sk next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ bet next 2 dc ) 2 times, sk next 2 dc , ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) bet next 2 dc ; rep from * 2 more times, (sk next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ bet next 2 dc) 2 times, dc in same sp as beg dc, join with sl st to beg dc with new color.
Rnd 4: SI st in ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in same sp, *(ch 2, sk next 2 sts, hdc bet next 2 sts) 3 times, ch 2, ( 2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in corner sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, hdc bet next 2 sts) 3 times, ch 2, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, ch 1 , join with sl st to beg hdc. Fasten off.

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Moss Stitch (even number of sts)
Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st) around, join with sl st to beg sc.
Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as sc + ch 1), *(sc in next sp, ch 1; rep from * around, sc in last sp, join with sl st to beg ch-2.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 1, *(sc in next sp, ch 1; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg sc. Rep Rnds 2-3 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

Motifs are worked individually and joined as you go, into a tube. The waistband and lower edging are worked upward and downward from the open ends of the tube.

## SKIRT

Using diagram as a guide, with larger hook, make 30 $(33,36,52,56)(60,64,85,90,95)$ Motifs, changing colors as indicated, joining motifs entirely into a tube. Motif 1: Rnd 1: CC8; Rnd 2: CC6, Rnd 3: CC1, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 2: Rnd 1: CC1; Rnd 2: CC5, Rnd 3: CC2, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 3: Rnd 1: CC2; Rnd 2: CC4, Rnd 3: CC3, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 4: Rnd 1: CC3; Rnd 2: CC7, Rnd 3: CC4, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 5: Rnd 1: CC7; Rnd 2: CC8, Rnd 3: CC5, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 6: Rnd 1: CC4; Rnd 2: CC1, Rnd 3: CC6, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 7: Rnd 1: CC5; Rnd 2: CC3, Rnd 3: CC7, Rnd 4: MC.

Motif 8: Rnd 1: CC6; Rnd 2: CC2, Rnd 3: CC8, Rnd 4: MC.

After the first Motif is made, join as you go on Rnd 4: Joining Rnd 4: SI st in ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in same sp, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, hdc bet next 2 sts) 3 times, ch 2, 2 hdc in corner sp, ch 1, sl st in corresponding corner sp from previous Motif, 2 hdc in same corner sp, (ch 1, sl st in corresponding ch-2 sp from previous Motif, ch 1, sk 2 sts, hdc bet next 2 sts) 3 times, ch 1 , sl st in corresponding ch-2 sp from previous Motif, ch 1, 2 hdc in corner sp, ch 1, sl st in corresponding corner sp from previous Motif, 2 hdc in same corner sp); either cont joining to other Motifs as est'd, or finish Rnd 4 as described in Stitch Guide.

## Lower Edging

With smaller hook and MC, join yarn to any join between Motifs along one open edge of tube.
Set-up Rnd: Ch 1, sc in same join, *sc in corner sp, work 1 sc in each sc and 2 sc in each ch-2 sp to next corner (approx. 13 sc per Motif), 1 sc in corner, sc in join; rep from * around, skipping last sc in join, join with sl st to beg sc $-130(144,156,170,182)(196$, 208, 222, 234, 248) sc.
With larger hook, work Rnds 1-3 of Moss Stitch patt, then rep Rnds 2-3 until Edging meas 114". Fasten off.

## Waistband

With smaller hook and MC, join yarn between Motifs along the other open edge of tube. Work Set-up Rnd as for Lower Edging.
With larger hook, work Rnds 1-3 of Moss Stitch patt. Dec rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch
patt over $49(56,62,69,75)(82,88,95,101,108)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd. Next rnd: Work even in est'd Moss Stitch patt.
Dec rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch patt over $48(55,61,68,74)(81,87,94,100,107)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd. Next rnd: Work even in est'd Moss Stitch patt. Dec rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch patt over $47(54,60,67,73)(80,86,93,99,106)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd.
Next rnd: Work even in est'd Moss Stitch patt.
Dec rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch patt over $46(53,59,66,72)(79,85,92,98,105)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd. Next rnd: Work even in est'd Moss Stitch patt. Dec rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch patt over $45(52,58,65,71)(78,84,91,97,104)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd. Next rnd: Work even in est'd Moss Stitch patt.
Dec rnd 6: Ch 1, *sc2tog, work in est'd Moss Stitch patt over $44(51,57,64,70)(77,83,90,96,103)$ sts and sps, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time -4 sts dec'd, $106(120,132,146,158)(172,184,198,210,224)$ sts and sps rem.

Work even in Moss Stitch patt, if necessary, until Waistband meas 3 ". Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements.

## Drawstring

With smaller hook and MC, make a chain
approximately $52(551 / 2,59,621 / 2,66)\left(691 / 2,72^{3} / 4,761 / 4\right.$, $793 / 4,831 / 4$ )", sc in second ch from hook and each ch across. Fasten off. Weave in and out of Waistband at third row from top. Alternatively, use a purchased drawstring.
