

Hexagon Super Scarf

SIZE(S)

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 14" Length: 60"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Couture Home (86% Acrylic, 14% Polyester; 9.88oz/280g, 245yds/224m)

• #1101-10 Harlequin – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 17 (12 mm) knitting needles or

size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

8 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Hexagon Pattern (multiple of 8 sts + 6)

Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Row 3: K2, *sl 2 wyib, k6; rep from * to last 4

sts, sl 2 wyib, k2.

Row 4: P2, *sl 2 wyif, p6; rep from * to last 4

sts, sl 2 wyif, p2.

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 3-4.

Rows 9-12: Knit.

Row 13: *K6, sl 2 wyib; rep from * to last 6 sts,

k6.

Row 14: *P6, sl 2 wyif; rep from * to last 6 sts,

р6.

Rows 15-18: Rep Rows 13-14.

Rows 19-20: Knit. Rep Rows 1-20 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Slip stitches purlwise throughout.

SCARF

Cast on 34 sts.

Work 2 rows in Garter st.

Next Row (RS): K2, pm, work Row 1 of

Hexagon Pattern, pm, k2.

Work in pattern as established, maintaining garter stitch border and working **Hexagon Pattern** between markers until piece measures

60" or to desired length. Work 2 rows in Garter st.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

Garter st Knit every row.

k knit

pm place marker

p purl

rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip
st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: knit on RS

rows, purl on WS rows.

WS wrong side

wyib with yarn in backwyif with yarn in front
