## Couture Jazz Jumbo Knit Scarf

Level: Easy



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 88"

**Width:** 14"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Couture Jazz™** (81% Acrylic, 19% Polyamide; 100gm/16.5 yds)

- # 26-13 Beige - 9 balls

**Needles:** Size US 50 (25 mm) knitting needles *or* size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Sewing needle and thread to match yarn

### GAUGE

3 stitches and 6 rows = 4" in Seed Stitch.

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### STITCH GUIDE

#### Seed Stitch

**Row 1:** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Row 2 for pattern.

### PATTERN NOTES

The cleanest way to deal with joining a new skein of yarn is to sew the ends together with needle and thread. Tuck the end of the new ball inside the end from the old ball. Tuck in all the raw cut edges. Use sewing thread and needle to sew the two ends together. We sew all the skeins together and wind the yarn into one giant ball before beginning to knit.

When weaving in the ends from your cast on and bind off, the best tool is your fingers. Simply poke and pull the yarn through the stitches, then use your needle and thread to sewn down the end in an inconspicuous spot.

### SCARF

Loosely cast on 11 sts.

Work in Seed Stitch until piece is 87" long, or until about 2 yards of yarn remain.

Bind off loosely.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
