PREMIER®



Checkerboard Blanket

By Premier Yarns Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approximately 40" x 40"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Couture Jazz*[™] (81% acrylic, 19% polyamide; 100gm/16.5 yds)

• 26-13 Beige – 10 balls **Needle:** US Size 50 (25 mm) 32" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Sewing needle & matching thread

GAUGE

3 sts x 4 rows = 4" Stockinette Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The cleanest way to join a new ball of yarn is to use a needle and thread to sew the two ends together. I fold the last 1-2" of each end into the inside of the tube (so that the raw edge is hidden) and quickly whipstitch them together. I sew all of my skeins of yarn together at the start and roll them into one giant ball before I start knitting.

Blanket

Cast on 30 sts. **Rows 1-3:** *K3, p3; rep from * across. **Rows 4-6:** *P3, k3; rep from * across.

Repeat Rows 1-6 until approx. 3 yds of yarn remains, ending with row 2 or 5.

Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Use your fingers to weave in ends. Use needle and thread to secure them in an inconspicuous spot.
