

Mitered Granny Baby Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 28" Length: 28"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns DK Colors™ (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 140g/383yds)

• #1071-04 Sweetheart – 3 balls **Hook:** US Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

13 dcs x 8 rows = 4" in Mitered Granny Pattern Save time, check your gauge.

BLANKET

Ch 4, join with sl st in first ch to make a ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch 3, dc 2 in ring, * ch 3, dc 3 in ring; rep from * 2 more times, ch 2, sc in top of beg ch-3 to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc 2 over joining sc from last rnd,
* [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in next ch-3 sp; rep from * 2
more times, dc 3 in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in top of
beg ch-3 to join.

Note: From here, the blanket is worked back and forth in row across two sides of your square, until you come to the border.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc 2 over joining dc from last rnd, dc 3 in sp between next 2 dc-3 groups, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in corner ch-3 sp, dc 3 in sp between next 2 dc-3 groups, dc 3 in corner ch-3 sp, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3, sk first 3 dc group, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to ch-3 sp at corner, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in corner ch-3 sp, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to end, dc in top of beg ch-3 of previous row, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc 2 in sp between ending dc and first dc-3 group, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to ch-3 sp at corner, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in corner ch-3 sp, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to end, dc 3 in ch-3 sp at beg of previous row, turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3, 25 more times, then work Row 2 once more.

Border

Ch 3, [dc 2, ch 3, dc 3] in sp between ending dc and first dc-3 group, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to ch-3 sp at corner, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in corner ch-3 sp, dc 3 in each sp between dc-3 groups to end, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in ch-3 sp at beg of previous row, continuing down side of blanket, dc3 in ch-3 sp at end of each WS row to end, [dc 3, ch 3, dc 3] in corner, continuing along other side of blanket, dc 3 in sp at end of each WS row to end, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block gently.
