
PREMIER®



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Notions: Tapestry needle

Width: 17" Length: 61"

MATERIALS

Premier[®] Yarns DK Colors[™] (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 338yds/350m)
#1071-33 Suede – 3 balls
Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needle or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Bias Wave Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Bias Wave Stitch (multiple of 10 + 4 sts) Row 1 (RS): K4, yo, ssk, sl2, k1, p2sso, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, *(k1, yo) twice, ssk, sl2, k1, p2sso, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, m1, k2. Row 2 and all WS rows: K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Row 3: K2, p2tog tbl, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2. Rows 5, 7 and 9: K2, ssk, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2. Row 11: K2, ssk, k2tog, k1, yo, *(k1, yo) twice, ssk, sl2, k1, p2sso, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from * to last 7 sts, k1, yo, k2, ssk, yo, k2. Row 13: K2, p2tog tbl, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2. Rows 15, 17 and 19: K2, ssk, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Rep Rows 1-20 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This wrap is worked from one end to the other. Decreasing at one edge and increasing at the other creates the bias shape.

WRAP

Cast on 84 sts, work 4 rows even in Garter st. Work a total of 21 reps (420 rows) of **Bias Wave Stitch**, or to desired length. Work 4 rows even in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
