

Easy Granny Stitch Shawl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 60" Depth: 37½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling DK Colors™ (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 383yds/350m)

• 1071-30 Parrot – 2 balls

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

6 granny clusters x 8 rows = 4" in patt Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The shawl begins at the center back neck and grows out and down toward the lower edge. The ch 3 (turning ch) at the end of each row to set up for the next row will always count as a stitch.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

SHAWL

Make Magic Ring.

Row 1: (Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ring, ch 3,

turn.

Row 2: Work 2 dc in first st, sk next 2 dc, work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, sk next 2 dc, work 3 dc in top of turning ch, ch 3, turn.

Row 3: Work 2 dc in first st, *3 dc in sp between the next 2 groups of 3dc from previous row; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, *3 dc in sp between 2 groups of 3dc from previous row; rep from * to end, work 3 dc in top of turning ch, ch 3, turn.

Rows 4-57: Rep Row 3.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Gently block to Finished Measurements.

dc double crochet

patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)

sk skipsp space
