

## Vintage Baby Cardigan

## SIZES

6 (12, 18, 24)m
Shown in 12 month size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 18 (20, 22, 24)"

## MATERIALS

Premier Yarns ${ }^{\circledR}$ DK Colors ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $100 \%$ anti-pilling acrylic; $5 \mathrm{oz} / 140 \mathrm{gm}, 383 \mathrm{yds} / 350 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- 1071-19 Iris - $1(1,2,2)$ balls

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) or H-8 (4.5mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle, 1-1/2" button

## GAUGE

18 dc $\times 8$ rows $=4$ " for smaller 2 sizes with smaller hook.
$16 \mathrm{dc} \times 7$ rows = $4^{\prime \prime}$ for larger 2 sizes with larger hook.
Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

When working a single dc into a st always work through the back loop only. When working 3-5 dc into a st work through both loops.

## CARDIGAN

Yoke
With smaller (smaller, larger, larger) hook, ch 72 sts.
Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook, *3 dc in next ch, dc in next 4 ch ; rep from * 12 more times, 3 dc in next ch, dc in last 2 ch, turn - dc sts.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), sk 2 dc , dc in next dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 98 dc .

Row 3: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, *sk 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc ; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 126 dc.
Row 4: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ dc in next dc , dc in next 3 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 3 dc; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 126 dc .
Row 5: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in next 3 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 3 dc ; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 154 dc .
Row 6: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in next 4 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 4 dc ; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 154 dc .
Row 7: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 4 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 4 dc; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 182 dc .
Row 8: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 5 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 5 dc ; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 182 dc .
Row 9: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in next 5 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 210 dc .
6 Month Size, skip to Sleeve Separation.
Row 10 (sizes 12, 18, 24 month only): Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 6 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 6 dc ; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 210 dc.

12 \& 18 Month Sizes, skip to Sleeve Separation.

Row 11 (24 month only): Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next 6 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc; rep from * 12 more times, turn - 238 dc.

Sleeve Separation (all sizes): Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next 5 $(5,5,6) \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next $6(6,6,7) \mathrm{dc}$, sk 2 dc, dc in next $6(6,6,7) d c, 3$ dc in next dc, dc in next 6 $(6,6,7)$, sk next $49(49,49,55)$ dc for sleeve, [dc in next $6(6,6,7)$ dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next $6(6,6,7)$, sk 2 dc] 4 times, sk next $47(47,47,53)$ dc for $2 n d$ sleeve, dc in next $6(6,6,7) \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next $6(6,6$, 7), sk 2 dc , dc in next $6(6,6,7) \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next $6(6,6,7)$, turn $-120(120,120,136)$ dc.

## Body (sizes 6, 12, 18 only)

Row 1: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 6 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 6 dc; rep from * 6 more times, turn - 136 dc.
Rows 2-3: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 7 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 7 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -136 dc.

## Body All Sizes

Row 1: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 7 dc, *sk 2 dc , dc in next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 7 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -152 dc .
Rows 2-3: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 8 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 8 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -152 dc . Row 4: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 8 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 8 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -168 dc . 6 Month Size, after Row 5 skip to edging, do not fasten off.

Rows 5-6: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next 8 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $9 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 9 dc; rep from * 6 more times, turn - 168 dc. 12 Month Size, after Row 6 skip to edging, do not fasten off.
Row 7: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next 8 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc, *sk 2 dc, dc in next 9 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -184 dc . Rows 8-9: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $9 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 10 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 10 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn-184 dc.

Row 10: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 9 dc, *sk 2 dc, dc in next 9 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc; rep from * 6 more times, turn - 200 dc. 18 Month Size, after Row 10 skip to edging, do not fasten off.
Rows 11-12: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 11 dc, *sk 2 dc , dc in next 11 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 11 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -200 dc .
Row 13: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ dc in next dc, dc in next 11 dc, *sk 2 dc, dc in next 11 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 11 dc; rep from * 6 more times, turn 216 dc.
Rows 14-15: Ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next 11 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 12 dc , *sk 2 dc , dc in next $12 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 12 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn -216 dc.
Row 16: Ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next $11 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in next 12 dc, *sk 2 dc, dc in next 12 dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in next 12 dc ; rep from * 6 more times, turn 232 dc.

## Edging

Row 1: Turn to work up right front, sc evenly to neck, ch 6, sl st to last sc to form a buttonhole, work 3 sc in corner, sc in each ch across neck, work 3 sc in corner, sc evenly down left front. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew button opposite button hole.
