

## Dish Mitt

Level: Intermediate



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 9"

Circumference: 9"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Home™ Cotton** (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 80gm/140 yds)

- #38-12 Turquoise (A) – 1 ball

**Premier® Yarns Washi** (100% Polyester 100gm/92 yds)

- #1034-13 Green/White (B) – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) knitting needles, *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

12 sts x 22 rows = 4" with both yarns held together

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### MITT

With A and B held together throughout, cast on 20.

**Row 1- 8:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across.

**Row 9:** \*K1, kfb; rep from \* across - 30 sts.

**Row 10:** Knit each st across.

Rep Row 10 until piece measures 7" from cast on edge.

**Next row:** K15, pm, knit to end.

**Dec Row:** \*K1, k2tog, knit to 3 sts before marker, ssk, knit 1, sl marker; rep from \* once more - 4 sts dec.

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last two rows 4 more times - 10 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

### FINISHING

Use tapestry needle to draw tail through remaining sts and pull tight. Use tail to sew side seam from tip to cuff. Sew sides together. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

**dec('d)** decrease(d)

**k** knit

**kfb** knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

**rep** repeat

**ssk** slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

**st(s)** stitch(es)
