Embroidered Hat

SIZES

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 18¾ (20, 21¼)"

Height: 11"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

• MC: 100-95 Khaki – 1 ball

CC1: 100-88 Butter – 1 ball

• CC2: 100-89 Peach Blossom – 1 ball

• CC3: 100-90 Dogwood – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular needles and US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needles and set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Knitting through the back loop (twisted stitches).
- Knitting small circumferences in the round.
- K2tog decreases.
- Embroidery.

STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Twisted Rib (even number of sts)
Rnd 1: *K1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Hat is worked from the bottom up in the round. Flowers are embroidered onto Hat using satin stitch, once Hat is complete.

HAT

With smaller needle and MC, cast on 84 (90, 96) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **1x1 Twisted Rib** for 2". Switch to larger needle, work even in St st until Hat measures approximately 9½" from cast-on edge.

Crown Shaping

Switch to dpns when there are too few sts to work comfortably on circular needle.

Rnd 1: *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

Rnds 2, 4 and 6: Knit.

Rnd 3: *K3, k2tog; rep from * to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

Rnd 5: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

Rnd 7: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

Rnd 8: *K2tog; rep from * to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

Rnd 9: K0 (1, 0), *k2tog; rep from * to end – 7 (7, 8) sts dec'd, 7 (8, 8) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

FINISHING

Using photo as guide, embroider flowers on hat using satin stitch, beginning and ending the petals for each flower at the same point. Hat is shown with one flower in CC1, and 2 flowers each in CC3 and CC3. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

CC contrasting color
dec('d) decrease(d)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

MC main color

p purlpatt pattern

pm place marker
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s)

st(s) stitch(es)

tbl through the back loop
