



## Granny Square Oversized Cardigan

### SIZES

XS-L (1X-5X)  
Shown in XS-L Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 48 (72)“  
**Length:** 30 (36)“

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Anti Pilling® Everyday® Worsted** (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- 100-74 Clay – 10 (17) balls

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### GAUGE

Granny Square = 6”

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches.
- Single, double crochet and half double crochet stitches.
- Seaming.
- Working in joined rounds

### STITCH GUIDE

**2-dc Cl (2-double crochet cluster):** [Yo, insert hk in indicated st, yo and draw up a loop, yo draw through 2 loops] two times, yo, draw through 3 lps on hk.

**2-tr Cl (2-treble crochet cluster):** [Yo twice, insert hk in indicated st, yo and draw up a lp, (yo draw through 2 lps) twice] two times, yo, draw through 3 lps on hk.

**V-st:** (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

**Dc2tog (Double Crochet 2 together):** Yo, insert hk in indicated st, and pull up a lp (3 lps on hk), yo and pull through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo and insert hk in next st and pull up a lp (4 lps on hk), yo and pull through 2 lps (3 lps on hk) yarn over and pull through all 3 lps (1 st dec'd)

### PATTERN NOTES

Cardigan is made in square motifs. Squares are worked in joined rounds with RS always facing. Finished squares are sewn together following a diagram to make the cardigan. Trim will be crocheted around the cardigan and sleeves to finish.

### Square Motif - make 52 (96)

Ch 5, join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as half of **2-dc Cl**), dc in ring (completes first **2-dc Cl**), ch 2, (**2-dc Cl**, ch 2) 7 times in ring, join with sl st to first Cl – 8 Cl, 8 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, (ch 2, **2-tr Cl**, ch 2) in next ch-2 sp, \*sc in next st, (ch 2, **2-tr Cl**, ch 2) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, join with sl st to first sc – 8 sc, 8 “petals”.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in next 2 chs, sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-2, sk next sc, sk ch-2, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next st, ch 3\*\*, sk ch-2, sk next sc, sk ch-2, sc in next st; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join with sl st to first sc – 4 sc, 4 (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) sets, 8 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st to ch-3 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), dc in same sp, sk 1 st, **V-st** in next st, sk 1 st, \*(**V-st**, ch 2, **V-st**) in ch-3 sp, sk 1 st, **V-st** in next st\*\*, (sk 1 st, **V-st** in next ch-3 sp) twice, sk 1 st, **V-st** in next st, sk 1 st; rep from \* around to last ch-3 sp, **V-st** in last ch-3 sp, join with sl st to ch-3 of beg ch-4 – 24 V-sts, 4 ch-2 sps.



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**Rnd 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st and ch-1 sp around, with (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each ch-3 sp in corner, join with sl st to beg ch-3 – 88 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

Block gently.

## Joining Granny Squares

Following the diagram for your size, join Granny Squares in preferred joining method.

Sew sides and sleeves together. Leave neck and front opening unseamed as noted in schematic.

## Border

**Rnd 1:** With RS facing, pull up a lp in bottom edge ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, work dc in each st across each side, work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each corner and in joining squares around neck work the following: dc in ch-2 corner of 1<sup>st</sup> square, **dc2tog** over both ch-2 corners, dc in next ch-2 corner or joining square, join with sl st to beg ch-3.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in each st around with (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each corner, join with sl st to beg ch-3.  
Fasten off.

## Sleeve Cuff

**Rnd 1:** With RS facing, pull up a lp in seam of sleeve, ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st to beg ch-3.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st to beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Rep on 2<sup>nd</sup> sleeve.

*Note: Sleeve can be made longer by rep Rnd 2.*

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## Tie

**Row 1:** Fdc 204 (276) (alternatively ch 207 (279) and dc in the back bump of the 3rd ch from the hk and each st across.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as dc), turn, dc in same st and each st across, and into top of ch-3 - 204 (276) dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, turn, dc in same st and each st across, fasten off. Weave in ends.

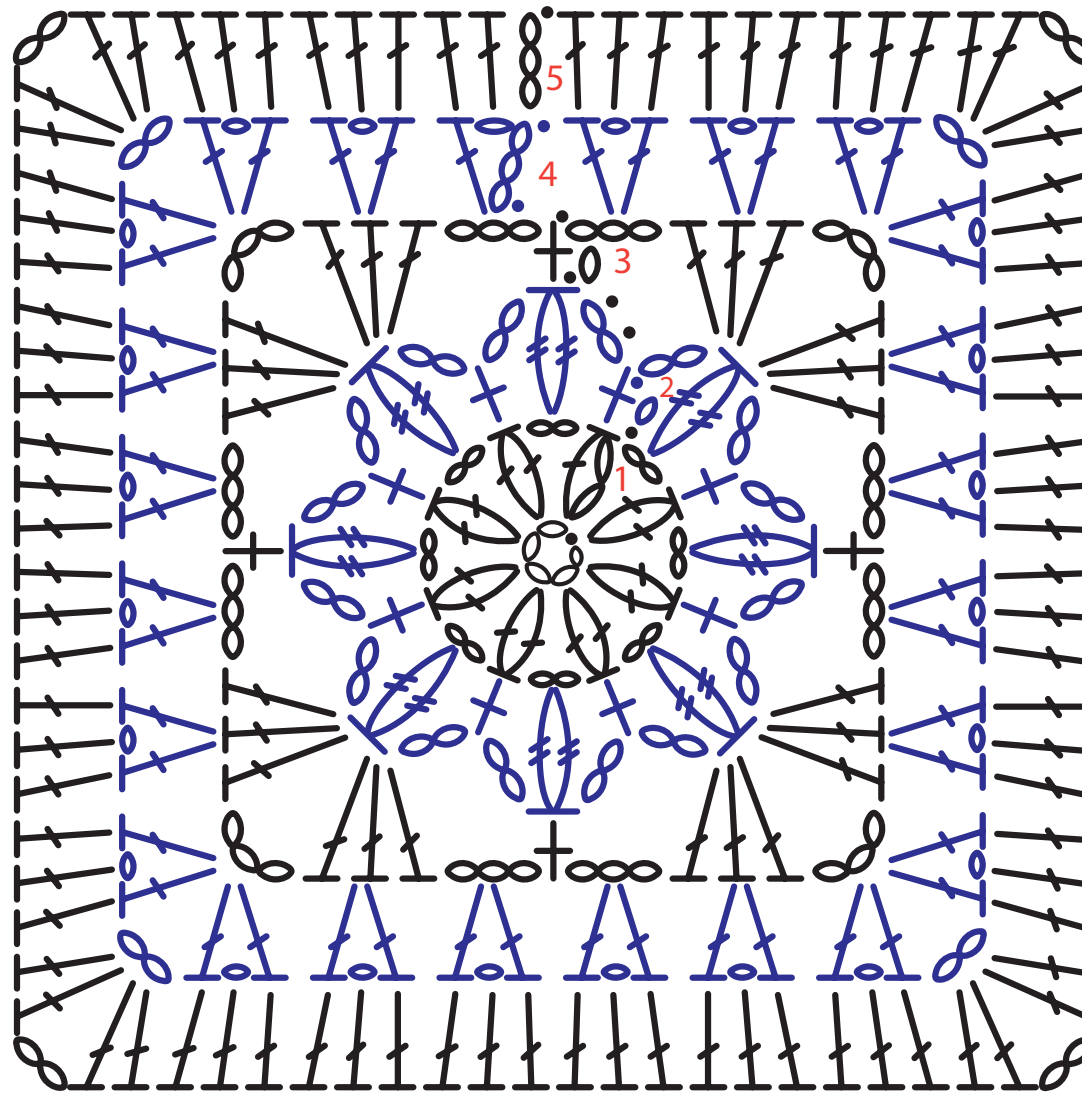

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## Square Motif



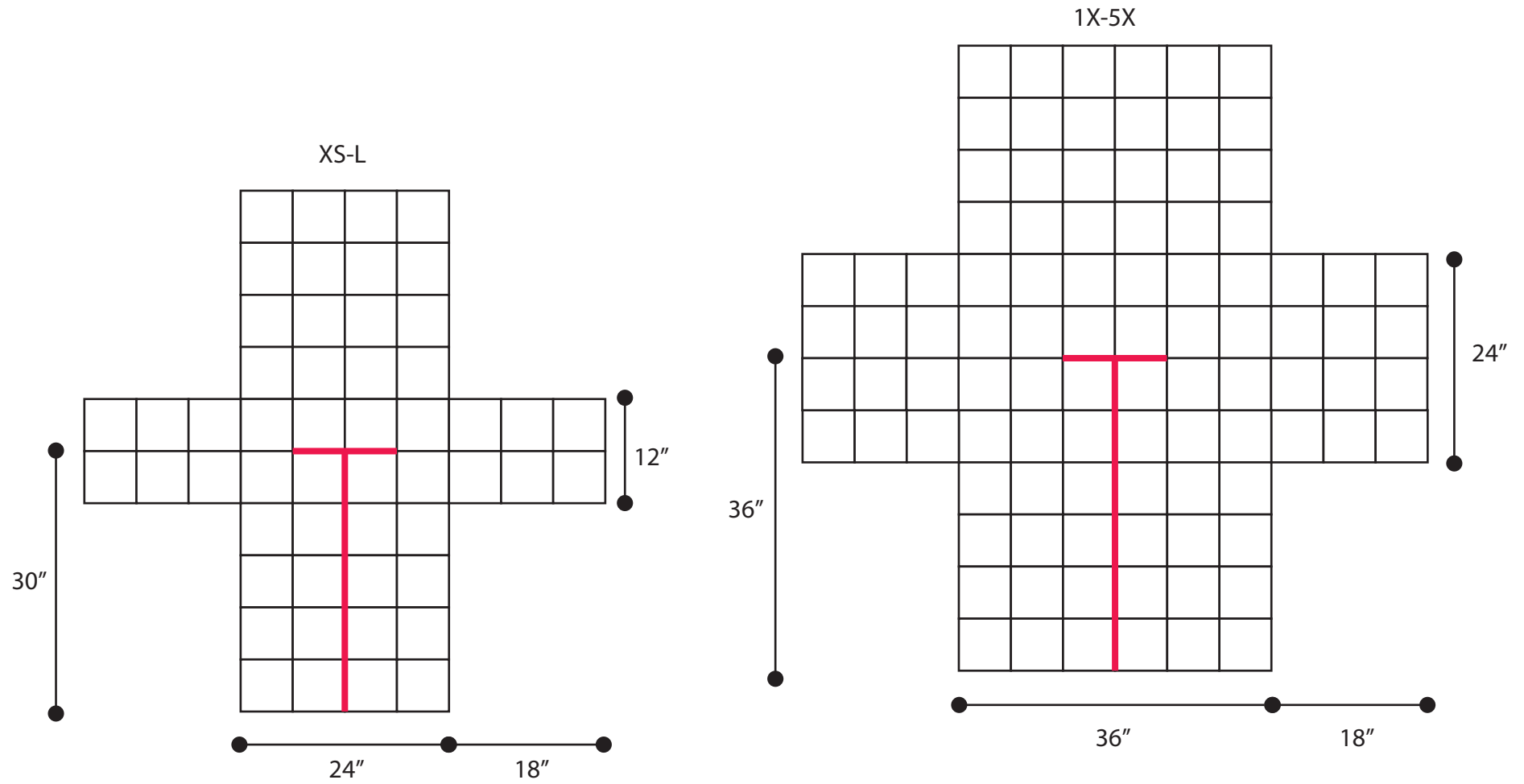
