# **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 50" Width: 7"

### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday®
Worsted (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

• MC: 100-92 Rosewood – 1 ball

CC1: 100-88 Butter – 1 ball

CC2: 100-71 Dove – 1 ball

CC3: 100-89 Peach Blossom – 1 ball

CC4: 100-93 Grape Jam Color – 1 ball

CC5: 100-91 Lake – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to

obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

14 sts x 13 rows = 4" in pattern Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and double crochet stitches.
- Single crochet join.
- Overlay mosaic crochet technique.
- Working in front and back loops of stitches.

# STITCH GUIDE

Back loop only single crochet (sc blo): Single crochet in the back lp only.

Long front loop double crochet (Lng fldc): Yo, insert hook in free lp of indicated st 2 rows below, yo and pull up a long lp, (yo, pull through 2 lps on hook) 2 times, sk the st on working row.

**Single crochet join (sc join):** Place slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through both lps on hook.

### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Scarf is worked flat, from side to side, using the Overlay Mosaic technique. The colorwork designs are created by working back loop only single crochet stitches in working rows and front loop long double crochet stitches in unworked front loops 2 rows below.

In Overlay Mosaic crochet, the right side is always facing, you will not turn your work. Instead, work each row from right to left and fasten off at the end of each row. It is not necessary to weave in ends. Instead, leave a 7-inch length of yarn before the first stitch of each row and before fastening off at the end of each row for the fringe.

You will never change colors within a row, instead, alternate colors every row according to the instructions and as shown in the color chart.

The Set-up Row and the first two and last two stitches of each row are the only single crochet stitches worked through both loops. The stitch count will remain the same throughout.

Read the chart from bottom to top, right to left. Each square represents 1 stitch. Squares with no symbol represent a single crochet back loop only, squares with an L symbol represent a long front loop double crochet, and squares

with an A symbol represent a single crochet through both loops.

## **SCARF**

With MC, ch 176.

**Set-up Row:** Working in back bumps of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn — 175 sc.

**Next set-up Row:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), sc in first 2 sts, **sc blo** across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off MC.

**Row 1: Sc join** with CC1, sc in next st, **sc blo** across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off CC1.

Row 2: Sc join with MC, sc in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts, \*Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off MC.

Row 3: Sc join with CC1, sc in next st, \*Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st\*\*, sc blo in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off CC1.

**Row 4:** Sc join with MC, sc in next st, sc blo in next st, \*Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts; rep from \* to last 4 sts, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off MC.

Row 5: Sc join with CC1, sc in next st, \*Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st\*\*, sc blo in next 3 sts; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off CC1.

Row 6: With MC, rep Row 2.

Row 7: Sc join with CC1, sc in next st, sc blo in next 4 sts, \*Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts; rep from \* to last 7 sts, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 4 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off CC1.

Row 8: With MC, rep Row 2.

Row 9: With CC2, rep Row 3.

Row 10: With CC3, rep Row 4.

Row 11: With CC2, rep Row 3.

Row 12: With CC3, rep Row 2.

Row 13: With CC2, rep Row 7.

Row 14: With CC3, rep Row 2.

Row 15: With CC4, rep Row 3.

Row 16: With CC5, rep Row 4.

Row 17: With CC4, rep Row 3.

Row 18: With CC5, rep Row 2.

Row 19: With CC4, rep Row 7

Row 20: With CC5, rep Row 2

Row 21: With CC4, rep Row 3.

# **FINISHING**

Trim Fringe evenly, block gently if desired.
