



Loopy Cowl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**Circumference:** 36"**Width (before seaming):** 15¾"**MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns *Anti-Pilling® Everyday®*
Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g,
 180yds/165m)

- A: 100-90 Dogwood – 2 balls
- B: 100-95 Khaki – 2 balls

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) *or size needed to
 obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sc x 15 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Front post treble crochet stitches.
- Loop stitches.
- Seaming.

STITCH GUIDE

Fptr (Front post treble crochet): Yo twice, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st, yo and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), [yo and pull through 2 loops on hook] three times.

Loop Stitch: Wrap the yarn from front to back over your index finger. Insert hook in indicated st, pull up a loop of yarn from the strand hanging behind your index finger, and pull through the st (2 loops on hook), you will have a long loop across your index finger, drop the long loop from your index finger to the back of your work, yo, pull through both loops on

hook.

PATTERN NOTES

This Cowl is worked in rows from end to end. The sides are seamed together to form a long tube, then the ends are seamed together to connect to tube and form the circular Cowl.

COWL**Section A**

With Color A, ch 60.

Setup Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 59 sc.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), **Loop Stitch** in each st across, turn – 59 Loop Stitches.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn – 59 sc.

Rep Rows 1-2 until Section A measures 18", end having just worked a WS Row. Join Color B, fasten off Color A, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Section B

Next Setup Row (RS): With Color B, ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in each rem st across, turn – 59 dc.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn – 59 sc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3, ***fptr** around next st 2 rows below, dc in next st; rep from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, *dc in next st, **fptr** around next st 2 rows below; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4 until Section B measures 18", end having just worked a WS Row. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

With RS facing out, fold Cowl in half lengthwise. Using mattress stitch, seam sides together to form a long tube. Working around the outside of the tube, seam the short ends together to close the tube. Fasten off, weave in ends.
