

Upcycled Flower Bag

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Diameter: 21/4"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday®
Worsted (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Any bag or object of choice to upcycle, large-eye hand sewing needle

GAUGE

Gauge not important for this project choose a hook size that is comfortable to work with.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and double crochet stitches.
- Seaming crochet applique onto fabric.
- Working in rounds.

PATTERN NOTES

These Flowers are worked in the round using 1 color. This project is great for all your *Anti-Pilling® Everyday®* Worsted scraps. You will need approximately 6 yards each of the following colors: 100-92 Rosewood, 100-88 Butter, 100-90 Dogwood, 100-93 Grape Jam, 100-91 Lake, and 100-94 Pumpkin.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

FLOWER (Make 2 in each color)

Create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Into the ring, work 10 sc, sl st to beg sc to join.

Rnd 2: *Ch 2, 3 dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in next st; rep from * around, ending with last sl st in beg join – 5 petals.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With the large-eyed sewing needle, sew flowers to bag using photo as a guide, or desired placement. Weave in ends.

beg begin(ning)

ch chain

dc double crochet

rep repeat
rnd(s) round(s)

sc single crochet

st(s) stitch(es) sl st slip stitch
