

Enigma Sweater By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 34¾ (39¾, 44½, 49½, 54½)" **Length:** 22 (23, 24, 25, 26)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Puzzle*[™] (100% acrylic; 200 gm/328 yds)

#1050-07 Riddle – 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) balls
 Needle: US Size 9 (5.5mm) knitting needles and US
 Size 10 (6 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge
 Notions: Stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

13 sts x 19 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch using larger needles Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

K2, P2 Ribbing (multiple of 4 sts + 2)
Row 1 (WS): P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

Stockinette Stitch Knit the RS rows, purl the WS rows.

Cable Panel (panel of 14 sts)
Row 1 (RS): P1, sl 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k3, k3 from cable needle, sl 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k3, k3 from cable needle, p1.
Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS): K1, p12, k1.
Rows 3 and 5: P1, k12, p1.
Rep Rows 1-6 for pattern.

PULLOVER

Back

Using smaller needles, cast on 62 (70, 78, 86, 94) sts.

Work 11 rows of K2, P2 Ribbing, beginning and ending with a WS row.

Change to larger needles.

Next row (RS): K25 (29, 33, 37, 41), pm, p1, k2, m1, k6, m1, k2, p1, pm, knit to end – 64 (72, 80, 88, 96) sts. **Next row (WS):** Purl to marker, sl marker, k1, p12, k1, sl marker, purl to end.

Next row: Knit to marker, sl marker, work Cable Panel to marker, sl marker, knit to end.

Next row: Purl to marker, sl marker, work next row of Cable Panel to marker, sl marker, purl to end. Continue as established, working Cable Panel between markers and Stockinette Stitch on each side, until piece measures 15 (15½, 16, 16½, 17)", ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes

Continuing in pattern, bind off 3 (4, 6, 7, 9) sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 58 (64, 68, 74, 78) sts.

Next row – Decrease Row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to marker, sl marker, work Cable Panel to marker, sl marker, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts decreased.

Continuing in pattern, rep Decrease Row every RS row 1 (3, 4, 6, 7) more times – 54 (56, 58, 60, 62) sts. Continue in pattern until armhole measures 6 ($6\frac{1}{2}$, 7, $7\frac{1}{2}$, 8)", ending with a WS row.

Shape back neck and shoulders

Next row (RS): BO 6 sts, k11 (12, 12, 12, 12) and put these sts on holder, BO 20 (20, 22, 24, 26) for back neck, knit to end.

Continue on left back shoulder sts only.

Next row (WS): BO 6 sts, purl to end.

Next row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end.

Next row (WS): BO 5 (6, 6, 6, 6) sts, purl to end.

Next row (RS): BO remaining 5 sts.

Return right back shoulder sts to needle and join yarn at neck edge.

Next row (WS): Purl.

Next row (RS): BO 5 (6, 6, 6, 6) sts, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Next row (WS): Purl.

Next row (RS): BO remaining 5 sts.

Front

Work same as back until armhole measures 4 (4½, 5, 5½, 6)", ending with a WS row. **Shape front neck and shoulders Next row (RS):** K20 (21, 21, 21, 21) and put these sts on holder, bind off center 14 (14, 16, 18, 20) sts removing markers, knit to end. Continue on right front shoulder sts only. **Next row (WS):** Purl.

Next row - Decrease Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end – 1 st decreased.

Rep last 2 rows 3 more times – 16 (17, 17, 17, 17) sts rem.

Work even until same length as back to shoulder shaping, ending with a RS row.

Next row (WS): BO 6 sts, purl to end.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row (WS): BO 5 (6, 6, 6, 6) sts, purl to end.

Next row (RS): Bind off remaining 5 sts.



Return left front shoulder sts to needle and join yarn at neck edge. Next row (WS): Purl. Next row – Decrease Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 1 st decreased. Rep last 2 rows 3 more times – 16 (17, 17, 17, 17) sts rem. Work even until same length as back to shoulder shaping, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): BO 6 sts, knit to end. Next row (WS): Purl. Next row (WS): Purl. Next row (WS): Purl. Next row (WS): Purl. Next row (WS): BO 5 (6, 6, 6) sts, knit to end. Next row (WS): Purl.

Sleeves

Using smaller needles, cast on 26 (30, 30, 30, 34) sts.

Work 11 rows of K2, P2 Ribbing, beginning and ending with a WS row.

Change to larger needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row (WS): Purl.

Next row – Increase Row (RS): K2, m1, knit to last 2 sts, m1, k2 – 2 sts increased.

Continue in Stockinette Stitch, repeating Increase Row every 4th row 0 (0, 0, 5, 5) more times, then every 6th row 10 (10, 12, 9, 9) times -48 (52, 56, 60, 64) sts.

Work even in Stockinette Stitch until piece measures 17 (17½, 18, 18, 18)", ending with a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap

Bind off 3 (4, 6, 7, 9) sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 42 (44, 44, 46, 46) sts.

Next row – Decrease Row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, knit to end – 2 sts decreased. Continuing in Stockinette Stitch, rep Decrease Row every RS row 2 (4, 5, 7, 8) more times – 36 (34, 32, 30,

28) sts.

Work 0 (0, 2, 4, 6) rows even.

Rep Decrease Row every RS row 11 (10, 9, 8, 7) more times – 14 sts. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 10 sts.

FINISHING

Sew left shoulder seam.

With RS facing, using smaller needle, pick up and knit 38 (38, 30, 32, 34) sts along back neck edge to shoulder seam and 34 (34, 36, 38, 40) along front neck edge to end – 62 (62, 66, 70, 74) sts. Work 10 rows in K2, P2 Ribbing. Bind off.

Sew right shoulder and neckband seam. Sew sleeves into armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Weave in ends. Block lightly.
