
PREMIER®



SIZES

Child (Adult S, Adult M, Adult L) Shown in Child Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 5¾ (6½, 7½, 8½)" **Length:** 6 (7, 7½, 8)

MATERIALS

Premier[®] **Yarns** *Ever Soft*[®] (100% Acrylic; 5.29 oz/150 g, 270 yds/247m)

- C1: 1138-20 Aqua 1 ball
- C2: 1138-22 Icy Blue 1 ball

Needle: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) straight needles, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle. **Save time, check your gauge.**

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Sewing/seaming
- Picking up stitches
- Small circumference knitting on dpns

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Pattern (any number of sts) Row 1 (RS): With C1, knit. Row 2 (WS): With C1, purl. Row 3: With C2, knit. Row 4: With C2, purl. Rep Rows 1-4 for patt. 1x1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts)
Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

The Mitts are work flat, then the cast-on and bound off edges are sewn together, leaving an opening for the thumb. Finally, the ribbing is picked up and worked in the round for the top, bottom, and thumb edging. Mitts are shown on next page with Pixie Dust City Block Cowl and Basix Worsted Seeded Columns Hat (both patterns available for free on Premier Yarns website).

MITTS (Make 2)

With larger needles and C1, cast on 18 (22, 24, 26) sts. Work even in **Stripe Patt** (beg with Row 1), until piece meas $5\frac{3}{4}$ ($6\frac{1}{2}$, $7\frac{1}{2}$, $8\frac{1}{2}$)" from cast-on edge. End having just worked a Row 4, with C2 bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew Mitts $1\frac{1}{2}$ (2, $2\frac{1}{4}$, $2\frac{1}{2}$)" along cast-on/bindoff edges, leave a 1" opening for thumb and then sew to end.

Bottom Edging

With C1 and dpns, pick up and knit 26 (28, 32, 36) sts around bottom opening of Mitt, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in **1x1 Rib** for 1½", loosely bind off all sts in rib. Rep for other Mitt.

Top Edging

With C1 and dpns, pick up and knit 26 (28, 32, 36) sts around top opening of Mitt, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in 1x1 Rib for 1/2", loosely bind off all sts in rib. Rep for other Mitt.

Thumb Edging

With C1 and dpns, pick up and knit 10 sts around thumb opening, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in **1x1 Rib** for ½", loosely bind off all sts in rib. Rep for other Mitt.

Weave in ends.


