

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: $28^{\prime \prime}$
Height: 19 "

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$ Bulky (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- 1068-05 Black (A) - 1 ball
- 1068-01 Snow (B) - 1 ball
- 1068-08 Red (C) -1 ball
- 1068-02 Linen (D) -1 ball
- 1068-06 Gold (E) - 1 ball

Hook: US Size L-11 ( 8 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, 2-1" safety eyes or buttons with needle and thread, pompom maker

## GAUGE

11 sc $\times 12$ rows $=4$ " in Single Crochet Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

This gift bag is worked from the bottom up beginning with one flat rectangular piece that is then joined to work in the round. When working in the round in this pattern, do not join with a ch or sl st at the end of each rnd. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first st of the round, and move the marker up with each subsequent rnd.

## STITCH GUIDE

MB (Make Bobble): Yo, insert hook in indicated st and pull up a loop, (yo and pull through 2 loops on hook) 5 times, yo and pull through all 5 loops on hook-1 bobble made.

## BAG

## Bag Bottom (Boots)

With A, ch 13.
Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across, turn-12 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc.
Rep Row 2 until piece measures 12 ".
Note: You will now work the final row to setup for working in the rnd for the Bag Body.
Setup Row: Ch 1 , sc in each sc across to last sc, work 2 sc in last sc, do not turn.

## Bag Body (Boots)

Setup Rnd: Continuing with A, turn piece at a 90 degree angle and working around the perimeter of the Bag Bottom (Boots), work 27 sc evenly along edge, work 2 sc in corner, sc in 10 sc along short edge to next corner, work 2 sc in corner, work 27 sc evenly along long edge, work 2 sc in corner, sc in each sc to end - 82 sc. Rnd 1: Sc in each sc around.
Rep Rnd 1 for $1^{\prime \prime}$.

## Pants

Switch to C and work Rnd 1 for 2".

## Belt Section

Switch to A and work Rnd 1 for 3 rnds.
Switch to C and work Rnd 1 for 2".

## Beard

Switch to B and work Rnd 1 for 3".

## Crochet Santa Gift Bag

## Nose Section

Switch to D and work Rnd 1 for 3 rnds.
Next Rnd: Sc in next 13 sc, MB in next sc, sc in each sc around.
Continuing in D, work Rnd 1 for 4 rnds.

## Hat

Switch to B and work Rnd 1 for $2^{\prime \prime}$.
Switch to C and work Rnd 1 for $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Next Rnd: *Sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from * around.
Next Rnds: Sc in each sc and ch-1 sp around.
Next 3 Rnds: Sc in blo of each sc around.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Mustache (Make 2)
With B, ch 4.
Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across, turn - 3 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc blo in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$, sc blo in next sc, 2 sc blo in last sc, turn - 5 sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc flo in each sc across, turn - 5 sc.
Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc blo in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$, sc blo in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ blo in last sc, turn - 7 sc.
Rows 5: Rep Row 3-7 sc.
Row 6: Sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ blo in next 5 sc , sl st in last sc, turn - 5 sc.
Row 7: Rep Row 3-5 sc.
Row 8: Sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ blo in next 3 sc , sl st in last sc, turn - 3 sc .
Row 9: Rep Row 3-3 sc.
Using photo as a guide, sew mustache pieces to face below nose.

## Eyes

Using the photo as a guide, sew buttons or attach safety eyes approx 1 " above nose.

## Belt Buckle

With E, using photo as a guide for placement, thread tapestry needle and cross stitch buckle onto belt.

## Drawstring

With C, make a crochet chain 36 " long. Fasten off. Weave drawstring through ch-1 sps in hat section.

Pompoms (Make 2)
With B, make pompom according to instructions that come with pompom maker. Sew one pompom to each end of drawstring.

Weave in any remaining ends.
