



Crochet Snowman Bag

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 29¾"

Height: 16"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday® Bulky (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- A: 1068-01 Snow – 4 balls
- B: 1068-08 Red – 2 balls
- C: 1068-05 Black – 1 ball
- D: 1068-25 Blush Pink – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- E: 100-94 Pumpkin – 1 ball

Hook: US Size L-11 (8 mm) and J-10 (6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker, 2 – 1" safety eyes or buttons in color of your choice with needle and matching thread, 2½" pompom maker

GAUGE

11 sc x 12 rows = 4" with larger hook

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Crocheting in the round.
- Magic Ring
- Changing colors.
- Seaming/sewing.
- Making pompoms.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

PATTERN NOTES

This Bag is worked from the bottom up beginning with one flat rectangular piece that is then joined to work in the round. When working in the round in this pattern, do not join with a chain or slip stitch at the end of each round. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first stitch of the round, and move the marker up with each subsequent round.

BAG

Bag Bottom

With A and larger hook, ch 13.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 12 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rep Row 2 until pieces measures 12".

Note: You will now work the final row to setup for working in the rnd for the Bag Body.

Setup Row: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last st, work 2 sc in last st, do not turn.

Bag Body

Setup Rnd: Continuing with A, turn piece at a 90 degree angle and working around the perimeter of the Bag Bottom, work 27 sc evenly along edge, work 2 sc in corner, sc in 10 sc along short edge, work 2 sc in corner, work 27 sc evenly along long edge, work 2 sc in

corner, sc in each st to end – 82 sc.

Rnd 1: Sc in each st around.

Rep Rnd 1 for 2”.

Scarf

Switch to B and Rep Rnd 1 for 1½”.

Face

Switch to A and Rep Rnd 1 for 6½”.

Hat

Switch to C and Rep Rnd 1 for 2”.

Switch to B and Rep Rnd 1 for 2½”.

Next Rnd: *Sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from * around.

Rnd 1: Sc in each sc and in each ch-1 sp around.

Rnds 2-4: Sc in blo of each sc around. Fasten off.

Rosy Cheeks (make 2)

With D and larger hook, make **Magic Ring**.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Using the photo as a guide, sew Rosy Cheeks on Face Section.

Nose

With E held double and smaller hook, create a **Magic Ring**.

Row 1: 3 sc in ring, do not join – 3 sc.

Row 2: 2 sc in each st around – 6 sc.

Row 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to first st – 9 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Mouth

Thread tapestry needle with length of C. Using the photo as a guide, stitch on the Mouth.

Scarf

With C and larger hook, ch 5.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rep Row 2 for 6”. Fasten off.

Tie in a knot in center and sew knot to side of Bag to finish Scarf.

Fringe

Cut 20 – 6” lengths of yarn. Holding 2 lengths together as one, fold in half forming a loop on one end. Insert hook into end of Scarf from back to front pull the looped end of fringe partially through the edge. Pass the loose ends through the loop being sure to keep ends even. Pull taut. Place 5 groups of fringe evenly across end of Scarf. Rep for other end of Scarf.

Drawstring

With B, and larger hook make a crochet chain 36” long.

Fasten off.

Weave drawstring through ch-1 sps in Hat section.

FINISHING

Eyes

Using the photo as a guide, sew buttons or attach safety eyes approx. 1” above Nose.

Pompoms (make 2)

With A, make pompom according to instructions that come with pompom maker. Sew one pompom to each end of drawstring.

Weave in ends.
