

**SIZE**

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 20 ½", excluding fringe and hanging pocket

Width: 14"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Bulky (100% antipilling acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- # 1068-14 Turquoise – 2 balls (C1)
- #1068-15 Aqua – 2 balls (C2)
- #1068-01 Snow – 1 ball (C3)
- #1068-09 Magenta 1 ball (C4)

Hook: US Size M-13 (9.00 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, scissors, ruler or measuring tape, one 1" diameter dowel at least 15" in length

GAUGE

8 sts/5 rows = 4" in main st patt

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

3Puff Stitch: (yo, insert hk in st or sp indicated, yo and draw up lp) 3 times, yo and draw through all 7 lps on hk.

Back disc: [(dc, ch 1) nine times, dc] in designated st or sp, remove hk from live st, place hk from back to front of first dc, pull live lp through to close, flatten disc down on back of row.

Front disc: [(dc, ch 1) nine times, dc] in designated st or sp, remove hk from live st, place hk from front to back of first dc, pull live lp through to close, flatten disc down on front of row.

Main Pattern Stitch (four row repeat)

Note: Ch 2 at beg of any row counts as first hdc.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2, 3puff in next st, *hdc in next st, 3puff st in next st, rep from * 7 more times, dc in each of next 4 sts, back disc in next st, dc in rem 4 sts, turn– 9 3puff stitches, 9 hdc, 8 dc, 1 back disc.

Row 2: Ch 2, 3puff st in next st, *hdc in next st, 3puff in next st, rep from * 3 more times, dc in next st, front disc in next st, dc in rem 15 sts, turn– 5 3puff stitches, 5 hdc, 16 dc, 1 front disc.

Row 3: Ch 2, 3puff in next st, *hdc in next st, 3puff in next st, rep from * 3 more times, dc in next st, back disc in next st, dc in rem 15 sts, turn– 5 3puff stitches, 5 hdc, 16 dc, 1 back disc.

Row 4: Ch 2, 3puff in next st, *hdc in next st, 3puff in next st, rep from * 7 more times, dc in each of next 4 sts, front disc in next st, dc in rem 4 sts– 9 3puff stitches, 9 hdc, 8 dc, 1 front disc.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Wall hanging is worked bottom – up using only one color at a time; fringe is added once main wall hanging is complete.

WALL HANGING

With C1, ch 29.

Row 1 (RS): 3puff in 4th ch from hk, hdc in next ch, *3puff in next ch, hdc in next ch, rep from * across (13 3puffs, 14hdc), turn.

Rows 2-9: Work main patt Rows 1-4 twice.

Row 10: With C2, work Row 1 of main patt.

Row 11: With C1, work Row 2 of main patt.

Rows 12-13: With C2, work Rows 3-4 of main patt.

Rows 14 – 21: Continuing with C2, work main patt Rows 1-4 twice.

Row 22: With C3, work Row 1 of main patt.

Row 23: With C2, work Row 2 of main patt.

Rows 24-25: With C3, work Rows 3-4 of main patt.

Rows 26-29: With C3, work main patt Rows 1-4 once.

Row 30: Ch 2, *3puff in next st, hdc in next st, rep from * across (13 puffs, 14hdc), turn.

Row 31 (hanging pocket): Ch 9, sl st in first st, *sc in next st, (sl st, ch 9, sl st) in next st, rep from * across (14 ch-9 sps, 13 sc). Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Bobble Edging

With C4, join yarn with a slip stitch on the top left hand corner of the wall hanging.

Row 1: [Ch 6, dc4tog, ch 3, dc4tog] This forms the two halves of the bobble. Connect the two halves by slip stitching into the bottom of the first half. Ch 3, sk 3 sts and sl st into the next st. Repeat from the beginning 7 more times or until bobbles reach evenly across the top of the wall hanging.

Making and Attaching Side Fringe

Cut (24) 5" pieces of C1, (24) 5" pieces of C2, and (24) 5" pieces of C4. Separate into groups of 4. Starting with C1 loop the yarn through the top left-hand corner to create fringe. Count down 3 rows and loop through a group of C2, then down 3 more rows with C4. Continue alternating and looping groups of 4 pieces of yarn to create fringe on both sides of the wall hanging.

Making and Attaching Bottom Fringe

Cut fourteen (14) 12" lengths of yarn from each of C1, C2, and C3. Group into fourteen bundles of 3 lengths (one of each color) and fold each bundle in half to form lp. With RS of wall hanging facing, attach all bundles evenly spaced along bottom edge by pulling each bundle at fold lp from front to back and thread yarn ends through lp. Once attached, trim any stray or uneven fringe ends.

Cut (66) 13" pieces of C4. Separate into group of three and loop 22 tassels onto the bottom edge of the wall hanging. Hang wall hanging and proceed to cut the yarn into a triangle with the shortest tassels on the outside and longest in the middle. Insert dowel in hanging pocket.
