

Drawstring Cowl

## SIZES

Child (Adult M, Adult L)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: $203 / 4(231 / 4,27$ )"
Height: $93 / 4\left(11 \frac{1}{2}, 121 / 2\right)^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier® ${ }^{\text {Y }}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling ${ }^{\circledR}$ Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$
Bulky (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- 1068-26 Mushroom - 3 balls (shown in Child size)
- 1068-28 Plum - 3 balls (shown in Adult M size)
- 1068-21 Navy - 4 balls (shown in Adult Lsize)
Hook: US Size K-10.5 ( 6.5 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

$91 / 2$ sc $\times 121 / 2$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Bobble stitches.
- Chain, single, double and treble crochet stitches.
- Front post double crochet stitches.
- Foundation single crochet stitches.
- Seaming ends together.


## STITCH GUIDE

Bobble: Yo, insert hook in indicated ch, yo and pull loop through, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, (yo, insert hook in same ch, yo and pull through, yo pull through 2 loops on hook) 3
times, yo pull through 5 loops on hook.
Foundation Single Crochet (Fsc): Ch 2, insert hook into 2nd ch from hook, yo, pull up loop (2 loops on hook), yo, pull through 1 loop ( 1 ch made), yo, pull through rem 2 loops on hook (1 foundation single crochet made). *Insert hook under 2 loops of chain at base of last st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull through 1 loop, yo, pull through 2 rem loops on hook; rep from *to desired number of fsc.

Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of indicated st 2 rows below, yo and pull through, (yo and pull through 2 loops on hook) 2 times.

## PATTERN NOTES

Cowl is worked flat and is seamed. Drawstring is threaded through the Mesh Upper Edge. To maintain stitch count throughout, always skip the corresponding stitch on working row if you have worked a stitch 2 or 3 rows below.

## COWL

Row 1 (RS): Fsc $49(55,64)$.
Row 2 (WS): Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), sc in each st and in each ch-1 sp across, turn - $49(55,64)$ sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next 4 (1, 1) st(s), *Fpdc around next 2 sts 2 rows below, sc in next 3 sc, ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * across, turn.
Row 4: Rep Row 2.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in next 4 (1, 1) st(s), *Fpdc around next 2 sts 2 rows below, sc in next sc, working in front of row, tr in next skipped sc 3

project continued
rows below, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next sc, working in front of row, tr in same st as last tr 3 rows below, sc in next st on working row; rep from * across, turn.
Rep Rows 4-5 until piece measures $81 / 2(101 / 4,111 / 4)$ " from Row 1 ending on a Row 4.

## Mesh Upper Edge

Sizes Child and Adult M Only
Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * across, turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * across, turn.
Rows 3-4: Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

## Sizes Adult L Only

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to last 3 sts, ch 1, sk next st, sc in last 2 sts, turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * across, turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to last st, sc in last st, turn.
Row 4: Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Seam edges of Cowl together.

## Drawstring

Ch 4, Bobble in 3rd ch from hook, chain until Drawstring measures $34(37,41)$ ", Bobble in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Weave Drawstring through ch-1 spaces of Mesh Row 2.
