



Expanding Cables Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 44½"

Length: 48¾"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday®

Bulky (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- 1068-32 Caramel – 23 balls

Hook: US Size L-11 (8 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 sts x 8 rows = 4" in Expanding Cables Patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and half double crochet stitches.
- Bobble stitches around posts.
- Front post treble and front post double treble crochet stitches.
- Working in front of stitches and into stitches 2 rows below.

STITCH GUIDE

Long Front post treble crochet (Lng Fptr): Yo twice, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of indicated st 2 rows below, yo and pull through, (yo and pull through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

Long Front post double treble crochet (Lng Fpdtr): Yo three times, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of indicated st 2 rows below, yo and pull through, (yo and pull through 2 loops on hook) 4 times.

Sideways Bobble (*worked around post of st*): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front

around post of the hdc, yo and pull loop through, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, (yo, insert hook from front to back to front around post of same st, yo and pull through, yo pull through 2 loops on hook) 3 times, yo pull through 5 loops on hook.

Expanding Cables Pattern

Foundation Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn.

Foundation Rows 2-5: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, hdc in next 3 sts, **Lng Fptr**, hdc, **Lng Fptr**, *hdc in next 2, **Sideways Bobble**, hdc in next 2*, **Lng Fptr** in next 2, hdc, **Lng Fptr** in next 2, rep from * to *, **Lng Fptr** in next 3, hdc, **Lng Fptr** in next 3, rep from * to *, **Lng Fptr** in next 4, hdc, **Lng Fptr** in next 4, rep from * to *, **Lng Fptr** in next 3, hdc, **Lng Fptr** in next 3, rep from * to *, **Lng Fptr** in next 2, hdc, **Lng Fptr** in next 2, rep from * to *, **Lng Fptr**, hdc, **Lng Fptr**, hdc in last 3 sts, turn.

Row 2, 4 all WS Rows: Ch 1, hdc across, turn.

Row 3 (RS): Ch 1, hdc in next 3 sts, sk next **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next st, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of st just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in skipped st, hdc in next 5, sk next 2 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 2 sts, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of sts just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in each of 2 skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next 3 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 3 sts, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of sts just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in each of 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next 4 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 4 sts, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of sts just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in 4

skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next 4 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 4 sts, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of sts just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in each of 4 skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next 3 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 3 sts, hdc in next st on working row, working in front of sts just made, **Lng Fpdtr** in each of 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next 2 **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next 2 sts, hdc in next st on working row, **Lng Fpdtr** in 2 skipped sts, hdc in next 5, sk next **Lng Fptr** and hdc, **Lng Fpdtr** in next st, hdc in next st on working row, **Lng Fpdtr** in skipped st, hdc in last 3 sts, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Throw is worked flat from end to end. To maintain stitch count throughout, always skip the corresponding half double crochet stitch on working row if you have worked a post stitch 2 rows below.

THROW

Work Foundation Row 1 of Expanding Cables Pattern - 89 hdc. Work Foundation Rows 2-5, then repeat Rows 1-4 of pattern until Throw measures 48", ending on a Row 1.

Last 3 Rows: Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn.

FINISHING

Weave in ends, block to finished measurements.

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning)
ch chain
hdc half double crochet

patt pattern
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sk skip
sp space
st(s) stitch(es)
tr treble
WS wrong side
yo yarn over

Chart

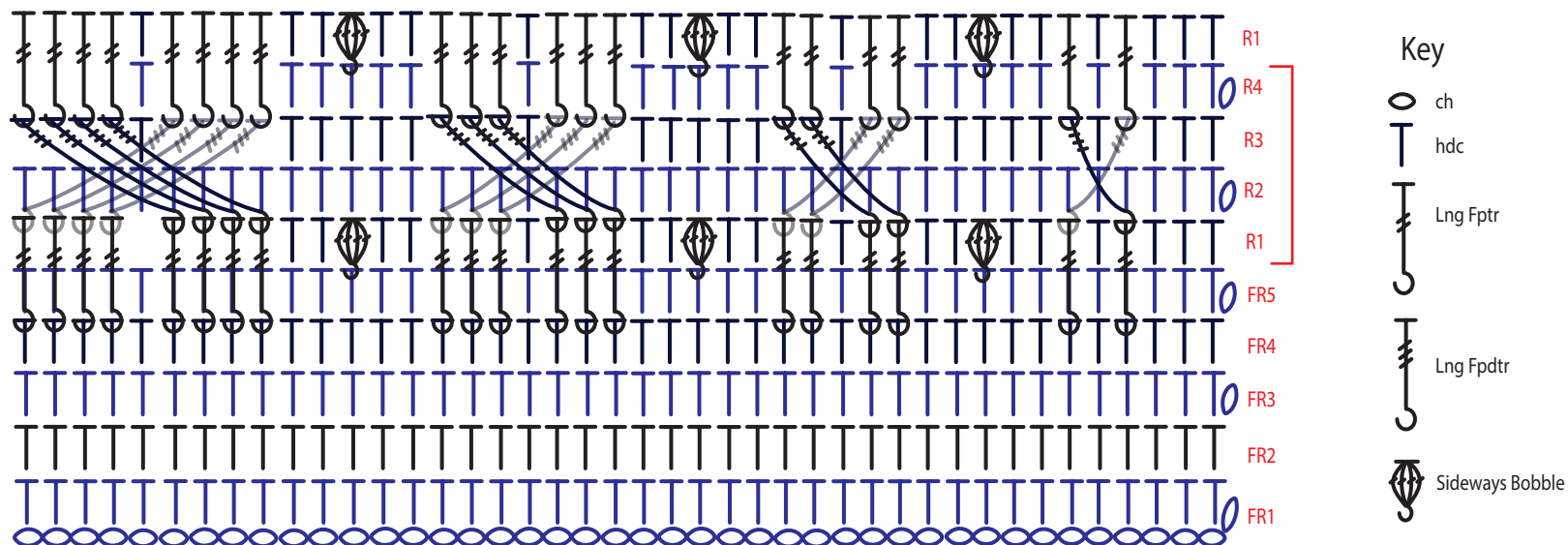


Chart represents first 42 sts of patt. The next 5 sts are (hdc 2, Sideways Bobble, hdc 2) and the rem 42 sts mirror the chart for 89 total sts.
