

**SIZES**

Adult

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS****Hat**

**Circumference:** 19 ½" Meant to be worn with 2-3" of negative ease

**Cowl**

**Length:** 53 ½"

**Width:** 9"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Everyday® Bulky** (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g 87yds/80m)

- #1068-13 Royal Blue – 2 balls, Color A
- #1068-01 Snow – 2 balls, Color B
- #1068-12 Sky Blue- 2 balls, Color C

**Hook:** US Size M-13 (9mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, scissors, stitch marker.

**GAUGE**

9 sts x 8 rows = 4" in Sc through the back loop

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**STITCH GUIDE****Horizontal Rib in the round**

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in bottom ridge lp in each ch across, sl st into the ch 1.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc flo into each sc across, sl st flo into the ch 1.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc blo into each sc across, sl st blo into the ch 1.

Rnds 2-3 form the patt st.

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

**PATTERN NOTES**

Hat and cowl are worked in the round. The hat is worked from the crown down to the brim.

The initial chain 1 in both projects does not count as a stitch.

When switching colors, crochet-in the tail ends over a couple stitches to avoid having to weave in a lot of ends later.

**HAT**

**Rnd 1:** With Color A, make a magic ring and work 11 sc into the ring. Sl st into the ch 1 of the round. Pm to mark beg of rnd. Draw the magic ring closed.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc blo into each st, sl st blo into the ch 1.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in the flo of next st; rep from \* around, sl st flo into ch 1. 22 sts.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, work 1 sc blo into each st, sl st blo into the ch 1.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in flo of next st, 1 sc in flo of next st; rep from \* around, sl st flo into ch 1. 33 sts.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, work 1 sc in blo into each st, sl st blo into the ch 1.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in flo of next st, 1 sc in flo of next 2 sts; rep from \* around, sl st flo into ch 1. 44 sts.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, work 1 sc in blo into each st, sl st blo into the ch 1.

## Fielding Crochet Hat &amp; Scarf Set

Level: Basic

# Fielding Crochet Hat & Scarf Set

Cut Color A. With Color B, insert hk into last st made with Color A, pull Color B through.

Work Horizontal Rib patt Rnds 2-3 three times (6 rnds total).

Cut Color B. With Color C, insert hk into last st made with Color B, pull Color C through.

Work Horizontal Rib patt Rnds 2-3 three times (6 rnds total).

Cut yarn. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## COWL

With Color A, Ch 120.

Sl st into the first ch you made, joining the ch in the rnd. Be careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of rnd.

Work Horizontal Rib patt for 2 rnds. Cut yarn.

With Color B, insert hk into last st made with Color A, pull Color A through, and work 2 rnds in Color B. Cut yarn.

With Color C, insert hk into last st made with Color B, pull Color A through, and work 2 rnds in Color C. Cut yarn.

Rep the sequence twice more to produce 9 stripes (3 of each color). Cut yarn and fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

<b>lp</b>	loop
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>patt</b>	pattern

<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>st</b>	stitch



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
